 may not be able to hold goods e.g. bulky or large quantities of items and these will be left at Gallipoli Legions or
 disposed of, it is the owner's responsibility to collect items prior to close on Sunday
- Any disputes or claims of missing items MUST be made at time of pickup. It is your responsibility to check that
 you have collected all of your unsold items.
- No 'Box Lots' of loose items, books etc. Please ensure that if you bring a box of items it is either sealed or each item is individually marked.
- When pricing items please use whole dollars only, no cents.
- The Newcastle Legion will not accept any item priced at less than \$2.00 and reserves the right not to accept any item submitted.
- All goods/monies must be collected before closing 18:00PM Sunday.
- Unless prior arrangements have been made, uncollected goods and or monies will be held by Newcastle Legion, and it will be the owner's responsibility to contact the Newcastle Legions and arrange collection. Any freight or postage to return items will be at the owner's expense.
- We may not be able to hold goods e.g. bulky or large quantities of items and these will be left at Gallipoli Legions or disposed of, it is the owner's responsibility to collect items prior to close on Monday.
- Any disputes or claims of missing items MUST be made at time of pickup. It is your responsibility to check that
 you have collected all of your unsold items.
- By lodging items for sale at the Bring and Buy you are acknowledging that you understand and accept these terms and conditions.

Frequently Asked Questions

How does this work?

Items for sale need to be packed for display and clearly labelled with three letters (e.g. your initials) and an item number, for example SBG001, SBG002, along with the price. Each item's details are to be recorded on the form above. If you need extra pages simply print more pages.

Please use the form provided, as handmade forms slow the process and often cause issues. We reserve the right to not accept forms if they are unusable.

When pricing your items please use whole dollars only, no cents.

How should I package my goods?

Goods should be packaged so that the buyers can clearly see the items, so in clear plastic containers (e.g. Take Away food containers) work best. These can also be stacked neatly as people will be looking through items. Loose pieces can be in plastic bags. Boxes and books can be simply labelled. No 'Box Lots' of loose items, books etc – each individual item must be labelled. Please ensure that if you bring a box of items it is either sealed or each item is individually marked.

Please ensure that you clearly label goods. Be aware that gamer hands will be touching goods so writing in dry erase markers on the outside will be rubbed off quickly. Also putting prices on paper inside the bags may make it hard for people to read. Please mark clearly in permanent marker. Use stickers to put on the outside of items.

What can I sell?

Pretty much anything, though be aware that CanCon is a gaming convention so popular items will be miniatures, board games and items of 'geekery' – there may not be a market for people wanting to buy or sell a chainsaw for example. We will not accept any item priced at less than \$2.00 (we recommend you group cheaper items) and we reserve the right not to accept any item submitted if we feel it is inappropriate, illegal or immoral.

How much should I price my good for?

This one we can't help you with ... There are generally 3 types of pricing we see though. The first is the 'wow what a bargain' price – where you put a price that people will buy just because it's so cheap. This is for the people who want to move stuff and don't really care what they get for it. This is what the early morning bargain hunters look for. For example a Space Marine Rhino (pre assembled, maybe badly painted or missing a gun or like) for \$10. The second is the 'good price', where you price something at a reasonable discount for people who buy it will get a deal, and you will get reasonable compensation, but you are not fussed if it sells, for example a Space Marine Rhino new in box (or on sprue) for \$30. (Remember that the traders in the hall may carry these good with discounts). The last is the 'premium price' and these are where you are selling an item where it has added value and you are looking for the exquisite buyer to purchase, for example a 2nd Ed Space Marine Rhino new in box for \$70. The issue you will face is the casual gamer will buy a new one cheaper, and you are looking for the person who wants the item and is willing to pay premium for it.

Can I adjust my prices once I submit them?

Yes you can. Simply show your ticket you receive and the team will give you your form. Simply update the prices on both the item and the form. Prices can be marked down at any time, however be aware that whilst you have the form we cannot sell your items so its best to do this at a quiet time, such as last thing in the afternoon or first thing in the morning. Please ensure that both your items and your form are marked as the form will be used in the case of any discrepancy.

Can I get an early payout?

Full Payouts are available at any time. Partial payouts are available subject to our workload at the time of collection.
