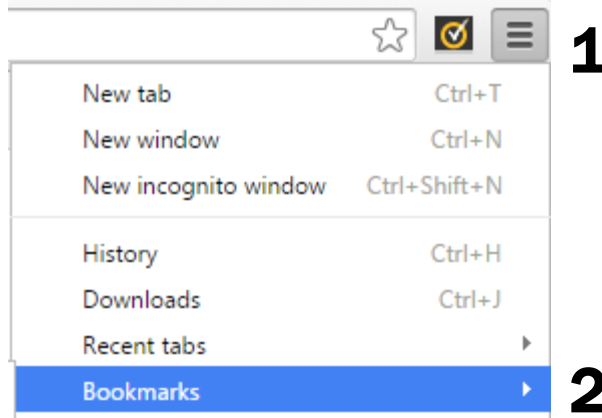
- **Edge will replace Internet Explorer as your browser**





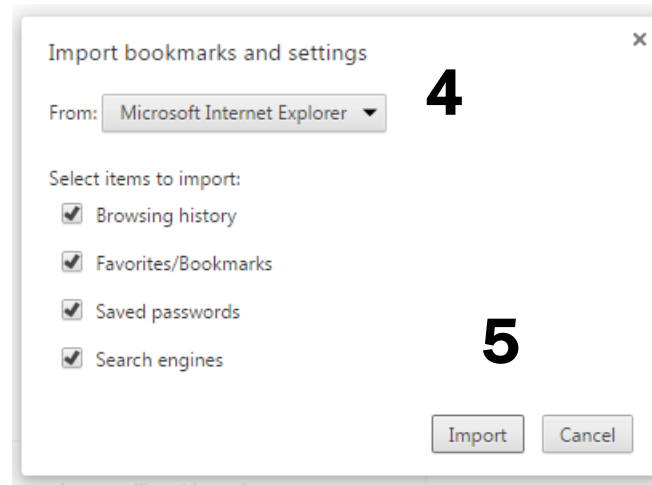
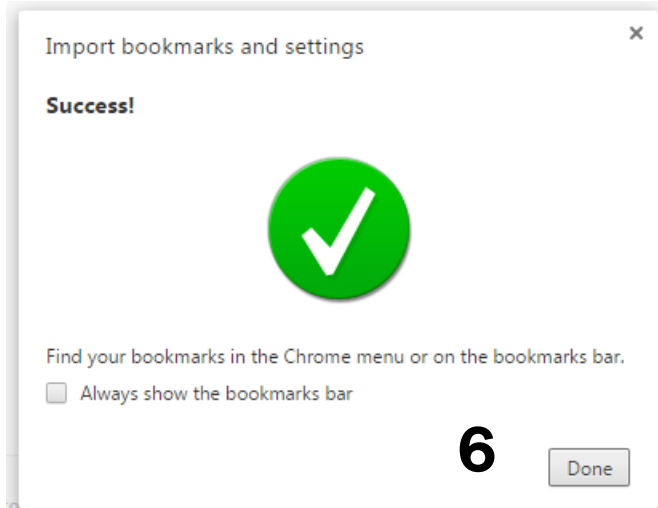
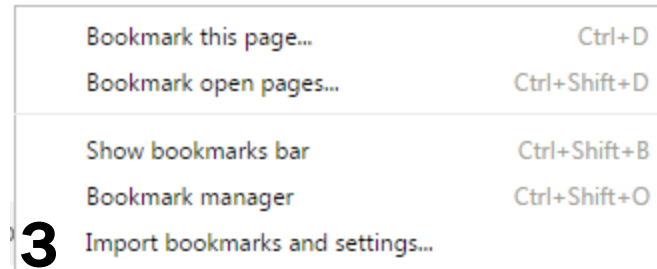
- **Edge will **NOT** import your favorites from Internet Explorer**
- **What to do BEFORE you install 10**
 - Install Chrome
 - Import favorites from IE
- **What to do AFTER you install 10**
 - Launch Edge
 - Import favorites from Chrome

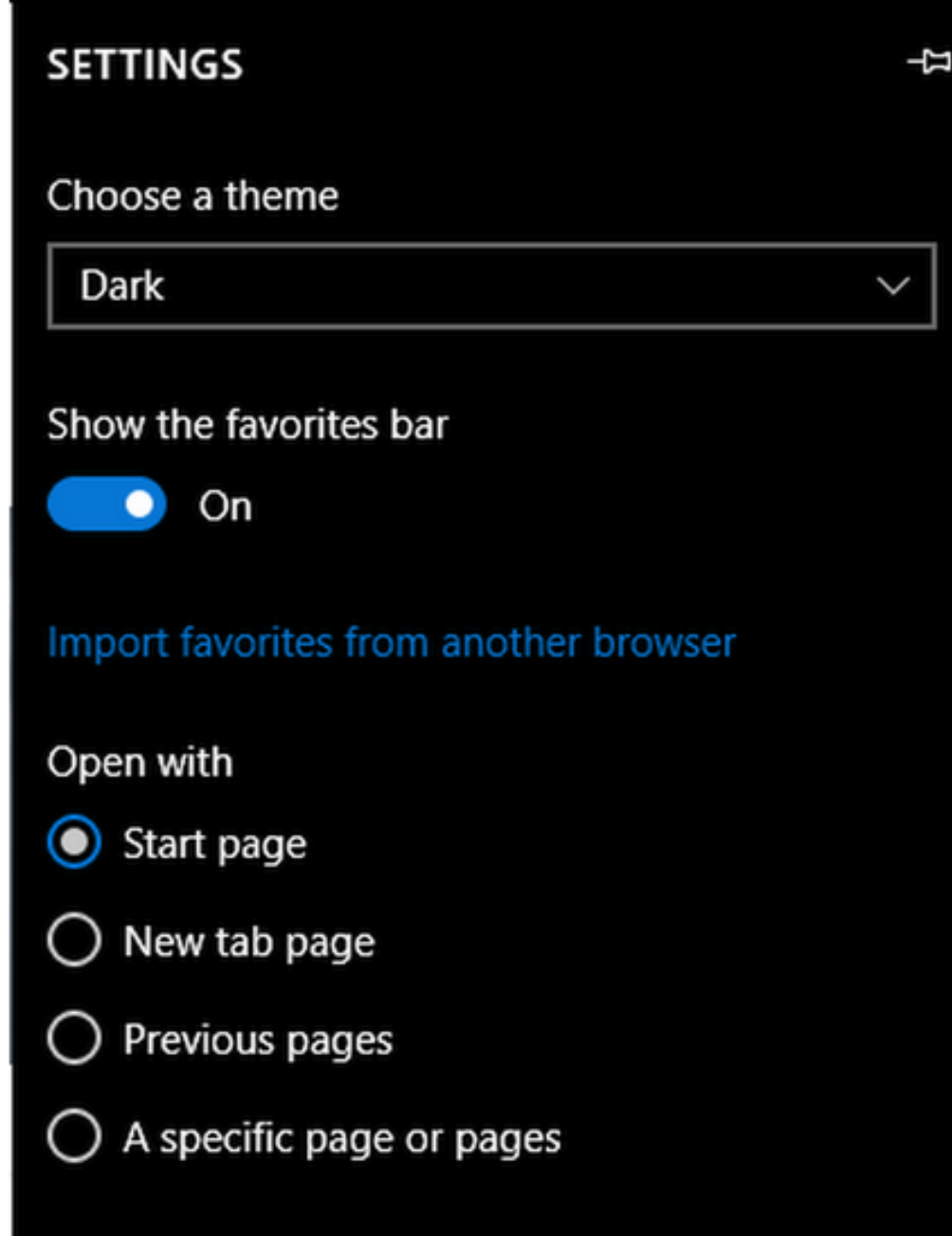
Chrome

1. Go to settings
2. Click Bookmarks
3. Import bookmarks and settings
4. Choose Internet Explorer
5. Check Everything
6. You will get a "Success verification click Done





- **Once we are on Win10 we will reverse the process**
- **Import FROM Chrome**



Always schedule restarts




- **Schedule WHEN Windows Update restarts the computer automatically.**
- **Force your PC to always prompt you to schedule a specific restart time**
- **Settings > Update & recovery > Windows Update > Advanced options**
- **Under Choose how updates are installed**
- **Pick Notify to schedule restart from the drop-down menu**

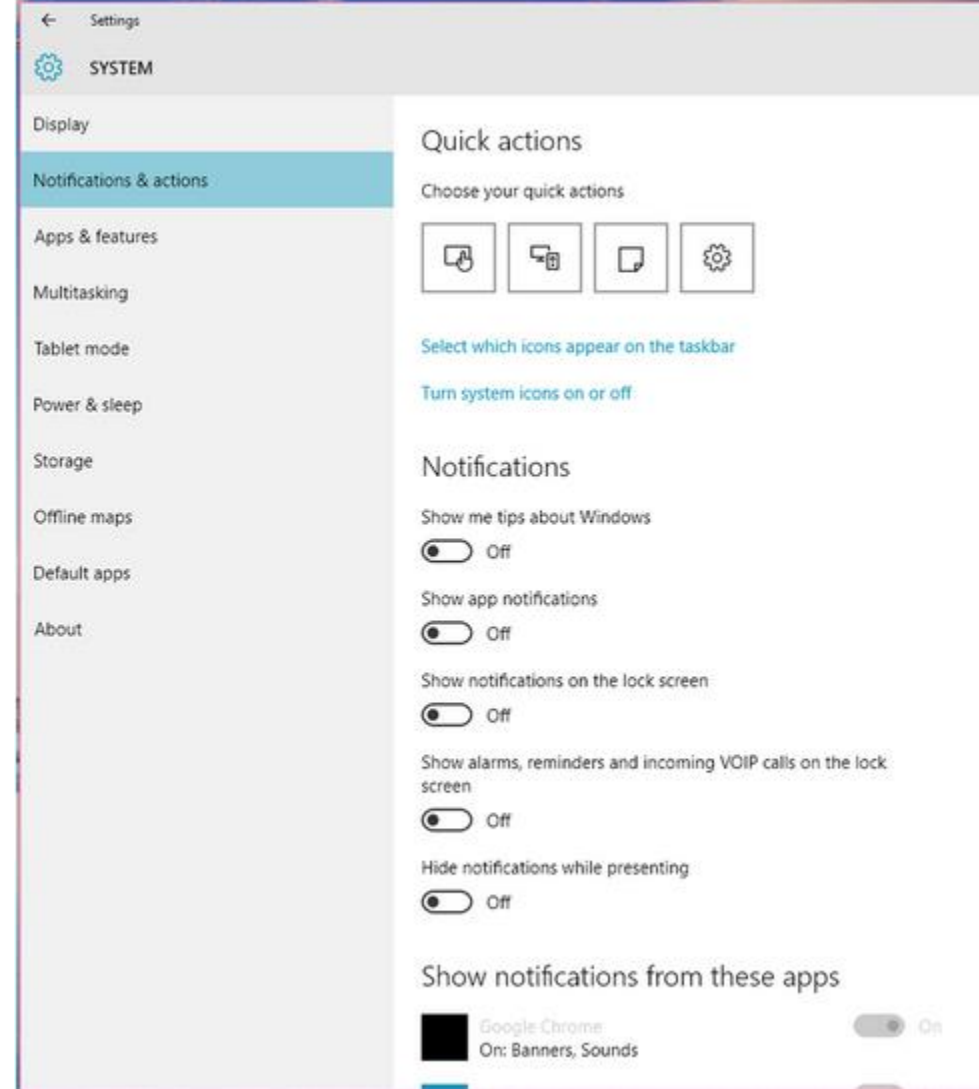

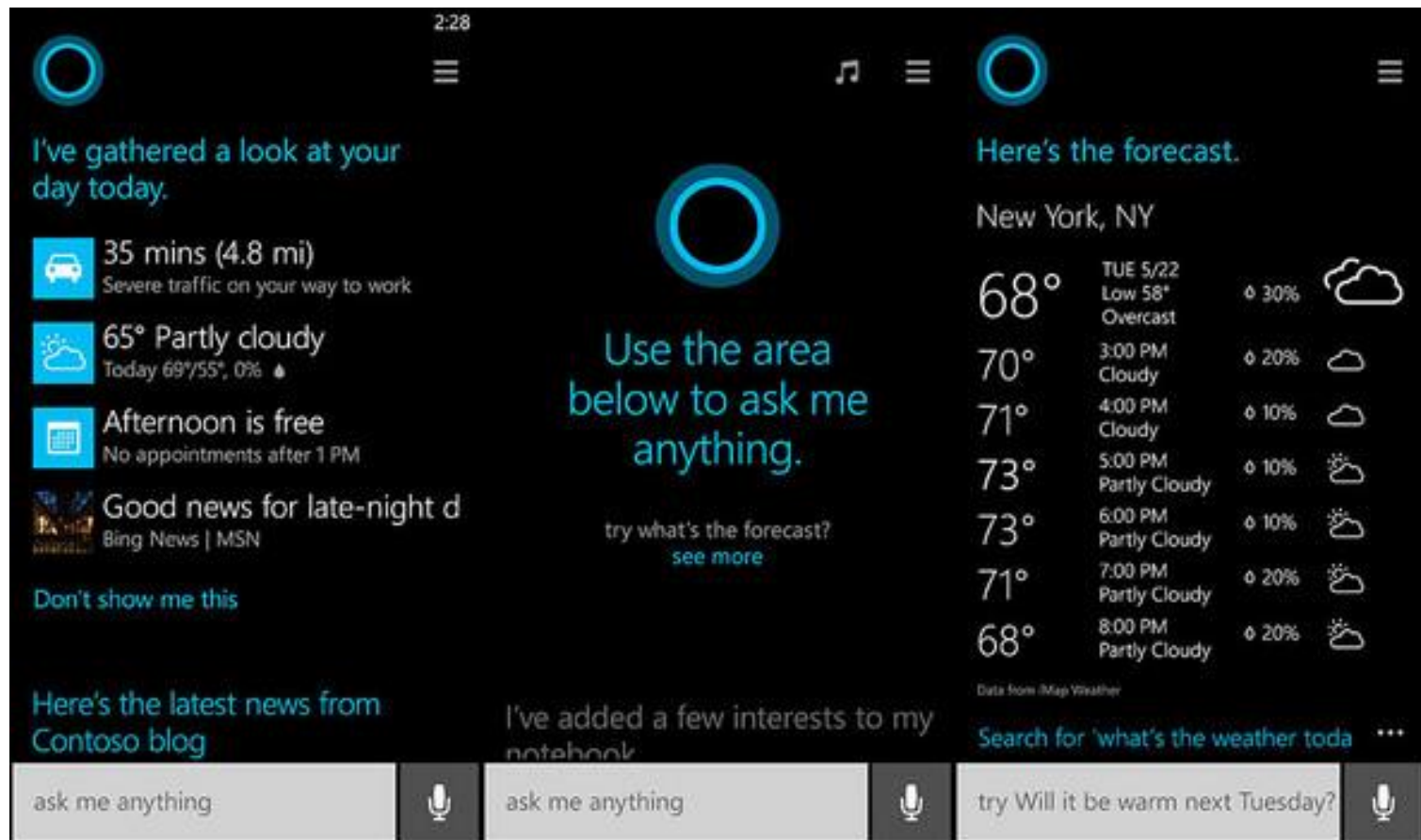

Set up Cortana — Hmmm ?

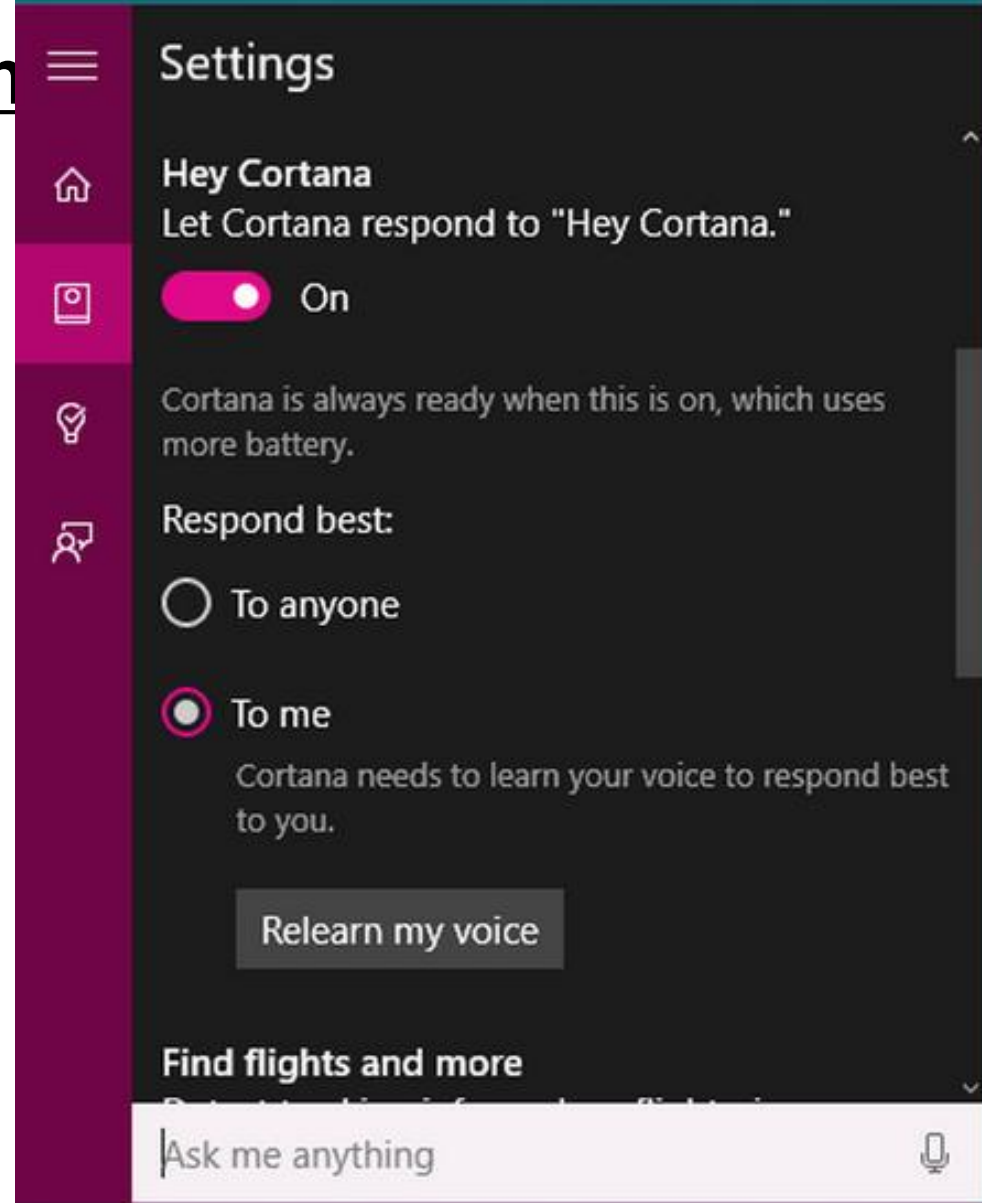


- **If you like the idea of a voice-activated personal search assistant like “Siri” on iPhone – Cortana is Microsoft’s version**



Turn on 'Hey, Cortana,' so you can activate Cortana with a phrase

- Go to Search
- Settings
- Under Respond best: choose To me
- Help Cortana learn your voice
- Repeat six phrases to her



Stop the sync party

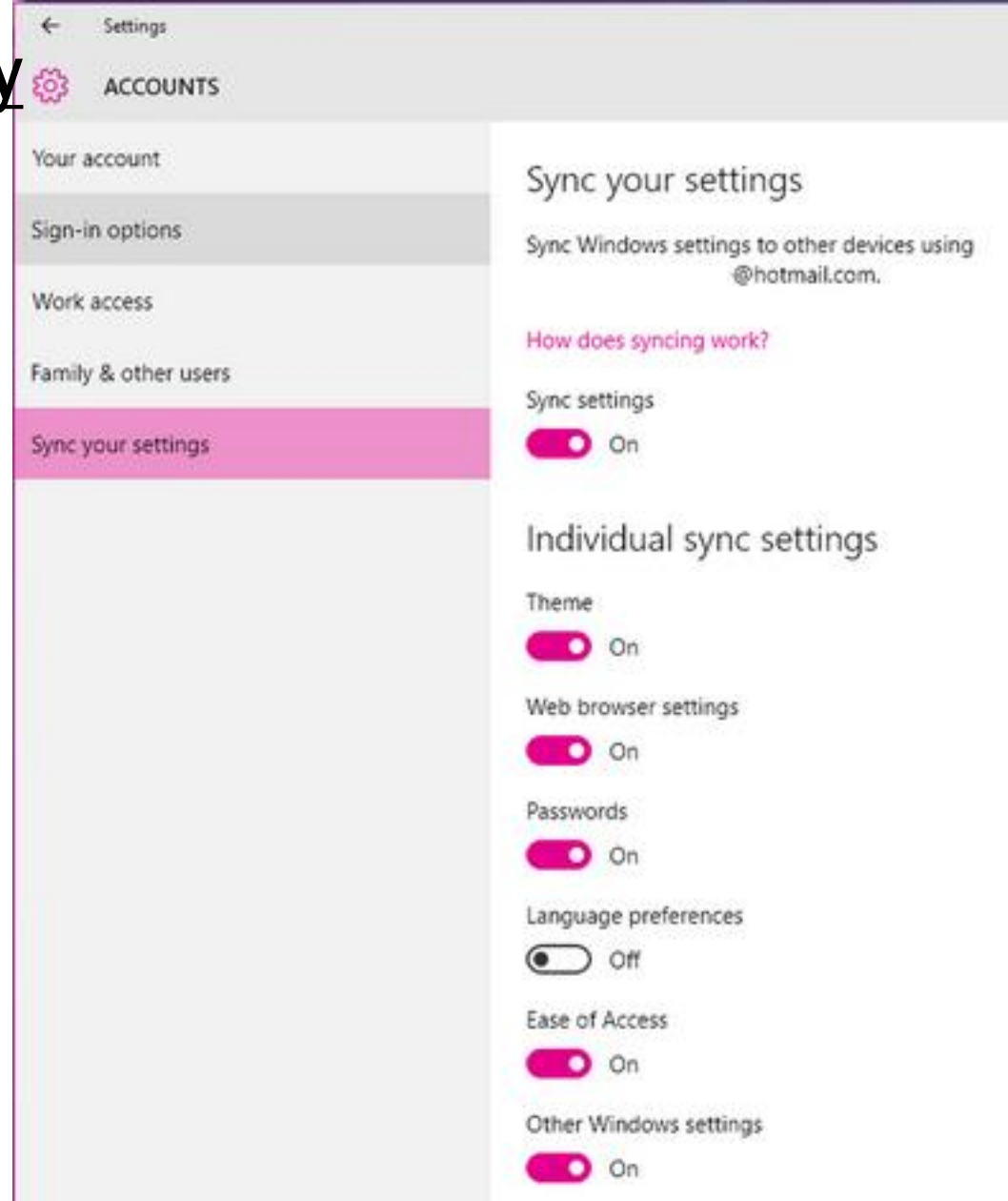


- **Windows 10 will sync all of your settings, themes, passwords, and other preferences and notifications across multiple computers and other devices**

Stop the sync party

Turn off syncing

- Settings
- Accounts
- Sync your settings
- Toggle off the various sync settings tied to your Microsoft account

Choose what app/program

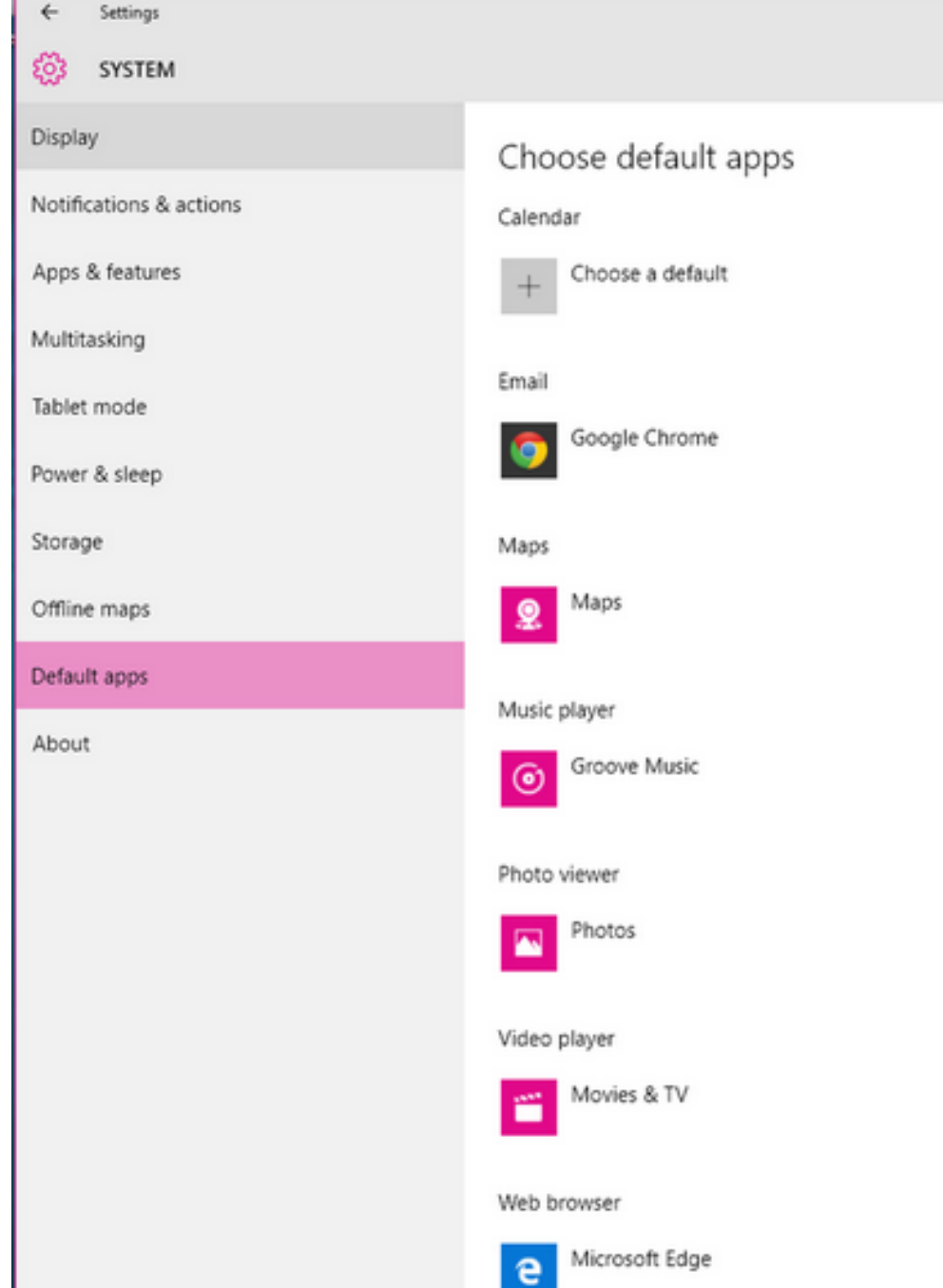
- **Opens**
