Lewiston, Michigan September 9-13, 2017

Event Details:

Located in Lewiston, which is about 200 miles north of Detroit in Upper Michigan and spread out over 3,000 immaculately landscaped acres, this property's topography features numerous ponds, streams and lakes set among mature hardwoods and pines - making it an ideal vacation spot for golfers. Our hope is that we'll catch the beginning of the Fall Foliage colors. Our participants will stay Garland's Main Lodge in their deluxe rooms, those who wish may opt to upgrade to a suite. With 72 holes of championship golf, first-rate dining and service, and a full service spa Garland is the perfect place to get away for a fall visit to Upper Michigan.

Beautiful Golf Courses are the absolute strength of this resort. The four courses onsite all offer a completely unique experience with their own type of challenges. Swamp Fire features water on almost every single hole. Monarch is literally cut from the trees, giving up little forgiveness if you stray from the fairway. The Fountains course has an elegance with water and breath taking elevated tee box views. And the Reflections Course is a club member's and area favorite. The pro shop features a large variety of both men's and women's clothing with an impressive shoe shining service onsite from a very friendly staff.

Garland offers Delicious Dining Experiences with a simple menu they have done a stand up job of offering menu items that they are able to deliver. Their friendly staff will make you feel right at home and serve up some of the best stories to go along with your food. The amazing outdoor "tiki deck" and large stone fireplace give you an entirely fresh air experience looking over the resorts beautiful putting green and Fountains Course 18th Hole green.

This will be a Self-Drive trip and we expect most participants to fly to Detroit(DTW), which has direct flights on Delta from Tampa(TPA) or Grand Rapids(GRR) which has a direct flight from St. Pete(PIE) or Traverse City(TVC), Flint(FNT) or Siginaw/Bay(MBS) which can all be reached with a connecting flight from most US airports. Garland is not really near any airport, so once you arrive in Michigan you'll have anywhere from 1.5 to 4 hours drive to reach the resort. However, we feel it's certainly worth the drive and since the SFGA has not visited this part of the country since 2010 we felt like it was time for a return visit. If you are interested in this event our hope is that you will also consider our event immediately following this one at the Grand Hotel on Mackinak Island!

Garland Lodge & Golf Resort:

Our members need to understand that Garland Lodge & Resort isn't a flashy five or even four star resort, in fact it is a rather homey rustic lodge that is as remote - and perhaps satisfying - as any golf destination in Michigan. Garland doesn't have one of the Great Lakes lining its fairways or even a big-name, world-renowned designer on which to hang its hat. Instead, Garland is more like a Golfer's Sanctuary thanks to four player-friendly but challenging courses and a rustic lodge that's also the largest log cabin east of the Mississippi River. The Garland Resort was founded in 1951 by the Otto family, and its four courses - Monarch, Fountains, Swampfire and Reflections - were all designed by Ron Otto, son of family patriarch, Herman Otto.

Ron Otto, who died in 2011, ran the resort until 2009. Starting in 1987, Otto plowed under the resort's existing 36 holes and, over the next decade, routed and designed the resort's four current courses. He also rebuilt Garland's lodge, which had been destroyed by a natural gas explosion on Labor Day 1985, expanding it from 27 rooms to a structure that now has several wings, three restaurants and a spa all within the largest log-frame structure you're ever likely to see. The building contains soaring cathedral ceilings, huge fireplaces, stained-glass windows and intricate hand-carved wooden statues as well as animal mounts from all over North America. It's like a hunting lodge on steroids; and that's a good thing.

The Otto family sold Garland to New Frontier Capital in August 2009. The new management team continues to showcase Garland as a classic four-seasons retreat, transforming in the summer from a winter wonderland of skiing, snowmobiling and alpine pursuits to an all-inclusive golf and outdoor destination in late spring through early fall. There's a new putting course and amenities have been expanded to now include fly-fishing outings on the nearby Au Sable River. More than \$6 million has been pumped into the courses, accommodations and other facilities; renovations have been made to the interior of the lodge and restaurants. Everything from the landscaping, pro shop, cart paths and sand traps has been upgraded. We do hope you'll join us on this unique SFGA Golf Adventure.

Golf Course Information:

<u>Swampfire Golf Course</u> is a gorgeous golf course featuring manicured fairways sculpted by pine and hardwood forests that lead to large, mildly undulating and mostly raised putting complexes. This is one of Garland's tightest layouts; however the toughest portions of the hazards are mostly taken out of play from the forward tee areas. On course golfers will be pleased with the simple fairway marking system, as red, white and blue stakes are readily visible on both sides of the fairways. Cart paths are also marked, as well as some sprinkler heads. The day's hole locations are indicated on the pin placement sheets that are provided for on the carts...be sure your cart has one before teeing off. As the slope indicates, Swampfire is a good challenge, and perhaps the toughest of the layouts at this resort. Doglegs, water hazards, bunkers and Fairways defined by mature forest - this course has it all. Prior course knowledge - or at least a quick study of the yardage guide will help...especially on the second and fourth holes.

Utilizing some of the original nine holes of this resort, Fountains has a unique layout consisting of a six-pack of par 3's, par 4's and par 5's. At nearly 6,800 yards, Fountains is aptly named for the numerous fountains and water hazards that adorn the rolling terrain and when you drive from the first green to the second tee you will cross the longest single span golf bridge in the world.

Monarch Golf Course Monarch is a just moniker for the majestic and regal feeling that you get from the towering white pines that line these fairways. Not short on stature as well, this is Garland's longest test at almost 7200 yards with a "Kingly" course rating of 75.3 and a slope of 143 from the Black throne. If that's not intimidating enough, Monarch could humble you from the get go as the first two holes are the toughest on the front nine. The back nine is just one great hole after another and the finishing holes are one of the strongest you will find anywhere. Pull out your driver here but be careful of the fourteen holes where water will come into play. No matter how well you are playing this day, make sure you take the time to look way up to the left, halfway down the 11th fairway. Bring your camera with a zoom lens because on my last visit, I actually got the rare pleasure to see a pair of mating adult bald eagles feeding a nest full of "youngins". A magical moment indeed!
