

## MUSIC CHA –

You have been selected for a very special purpose. As a Music Cha your primary purpose in all that you do is Pray. God will use you in wondrous and mighty ways before, during and after the weekend. This overview will give you a guideline and walk you through the steps in preparing for the weekend and set ups during the weekend.

As a Cha, remember it is important to pray and serve. That is your job. Think of each thing you do as an act of love and service – the music you play/sing will be powerful to the pilgrims.

### Team Building Dates

- Prepare music

### Thursday of the Weekend:

- Help unload the trailer, place bins in proper location.
- Prayer Walk- all team.
- Set up sound system
- Meet and Greet / pilgrims
- Greet pilgrims upon arrival and help unload luggage
- Attend Stations of the Cross
- Select special music (3 songs)
- Rehearse/prepare the chapel music

### Friday of the Weekend:

- Play music at morning Chapel (Communion included)
- Take Songbooks to Chapel and Rollo Room
- Bring the pilgrims into worship through music in the Rollo Room (3 songs before each Rollist/Rollista)
- Play / sing in song – “DeColores” for lunch
- Attend Poster Party (Rollo Room)
- Sing or play meditative music during Footwashing
- Sign bibles in Rollo Room
- Team Meeting
- Rehearse / Prepare music for morning Chapel
- If there is no Rollo Room Cha – assist keeping the snack table restocked.



### Saturday of the Weekend:

- Play music at morning Chapel (Communion included)
  - Play “I Just Wanna Be A Sheep” at breakfast
- Cha Theatre (Mary Had a Little Lamb Skit)
- Bring the pilgrims into worship through music in the Rollo Room (3 songs before each Rollist/Rollista)
  - Sing / play during Dying Moments
  - If needed assist with serving during Agape dinner
  - If needed assist with serving during Agape dinner
  - If needed – assist during Agape Serenade with 4<sup>th</sup> Day
  - Set out Agape songbooks
- Attend Poster Party
  - Sign bibles in Rollo Room
  - Team Meeting
  - Rehearse / Prepare music for morning Chapel
  - If there is no Rollo Room Cha – assist keeping the snack table restocked.

## Sunday of the Weekend:

- Mananitas (attend Chapel and sing the pilgrims in)
- Bring the pilgrims into worship through music in the Rollo Room (3 songs before each Rollist/Rollista)
- Load as much as you can in the trailer
- Help tear down Rollo Room / Set Up for Clausura
- Make sure all sound equipment is ready to go for Clausura
- Attend Rector/Rectora's talk
- Men attend Closed Clausura
- Help welcome in the pilgrims at the Clausura!!!
- Assist with final loading of trailer and do a final sweep of all cabins and help pick up the room where we did the Clausura!

After the Clausura it is important that you help pick up and put things back where we need to. We would like to keep the camp we are using in the same or better shape than when we arrived on Thursday. Please be willing to offer a helping hand in the end so that everyone can leave the retreat in a timely manner. God's blessings on your time serving HIM as a Music Cha!

## CHA CHECKLIST – WHAT TO BRING

- A Servant's Heart
- Bible
- Pilgrim Guide
- Name tag (plain bologna and decorated)
- Cross necklace (for Open Clausura)
- Personal items (toothbrush, paste, soap, chap stick)
- Medications / vitamins
- Towel & washcloth
- Bedding (pillow, sheets, blankets, sleeping bag)
- Alarm clock
- Agape clothes (white shirt, dark pants/skirt, comfortable shoes)
- DeColores clothing
- Apron
- Flashlight (for walking to chapel on Thursday night)
- Jacket / sweater/ raincoat
- Palanca for pilgrims and lastly team (notes, food, etc.)

***Please ensure that palanca is complete before the weekend.***
