

Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Catholic Schools in the Archdiocese of Miami will be administering a new standardized achievement test beginning in the Spring of 2019 as a part of their comprehensive assessment program. The new *TerraNova-Complete Battery* achievement tests, created by Data Recognition Corporation (DRC), includes norms developed in the year 2018 and measure student progress toward National Standards.

The information received from a norm-referenced test, such as the TerraNova, will provide schools with data that will help confirm the progress of students toward nationally recognized content standards. Analysis of the performance outcomes, together with information collected in classrooms throughout the academic year, will allow educators to more effectively meet the needs of individual students and instructional groups. Additionally, this information will also help teachers assess the need for use of differentiated instructional strategies that will increase the probability that all students will be successful.

How will the TerraNova Assessment be different from the Iowa Test of Basic Skills?

- More up-to-date comparison of performance to other students in the nation
