From the Pastoral Associate: In today's Gospel, the scholar of the law may be like us, for his knowledge of the law and its truth was correct. His question indicated that he knew that you did not earn your way to eternal life, but you are granted it by the loving grace of the Father who gives it to us as an inheritance. His answer to Jesus question about the law shows that he not only knows the Sherma found in the Old Testament that a good Jew prayed 4-5 times a day, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind," but he also adds to it the golden rule found also in the Old Testament (and in every major religion of the world today). Jesus approves of his answer. Where the scholar fails is the limitation that he places on his heart. For his love is only meant for certain people, perhaps friends, countrymen, other people who look or think like him. As mentioned in the second reading the Son of God has all of creation come through Him and for Him. God is the Father of all Creation, all the people of the Earth. God's love is limitless, it is like and is God Himself limitless. If we are to be like-God, adopted children of Christ, to be given our inheritance of eternal life, then our love needs to try to be like our Father's in Heaven, limitless. Our love for others needs to be without boundaries, no race, no creed, no gender, no sexual orientation, and no nationality can be a limit. Likewise, the degree of a person's sin or holiness, wealth or poverty cannot be a hinderance for our love. In the name of Jesus, let us all beg the Holy Spirit to help us expand our love, so we will live as true children pleasing to God both now and forever. Amen. ~ Michael Pekar
