Day 1 Sun, 19 Jul St. Petersburg (D)

Welcome to St. Petersburg. If you had a hundred years, you couldn't exhaust all the wonder on offer here.

Day 2 Mon, 20 Jul St. Petersburg (B,L,D)

Freechoice: Explore Catherine's Block and the fountains in the Lower Garden at Peterhof on a guided tour, or be seduced by the sheer extravagance of Peterhof's Grand Palace. Alternatively, wander the incomparable Upper and Lower Gardens at Peterhof.

Enjoy lunch in a local St. Petersburg restaurant, followed by a guided tour of this beautiful metropolis.

Day 3 Tue, 21 Jul St. Petersburg (B,L,D)

Freechoice: Visit magnificent St. Isaac's Cathedral or discover the Yusupov Palace.

Following lunch in a local restaurant, enjoy a cruise along the city's canals. This evening, you're invited to join Scenic Tsar's Captain for the official welcome dinner.

Day 4 Wed, 22 Jul St. Petersburg (B,L,D)

Visit Catherine's Palace, famous for its grandiose white and gold façade and elaborate gardens. Afterwards enjoy a highlight lunch at the old-world wooden Podvorie restaurant. This afternoon, enjoy some free time to explore or relax as you please.

Tonight you'll be treated to a glass of sparkling wine, followed by a private Russian ballet concert at the majestic Palace of Prince Vladimir.

Day 5 Thu, 23 Jul St. Petersburg (B,L,D)

A special highlight awaits as you visit the Hermitage, formerly the Winter Palace and home to Russia's Imperial family. Today it houses one of the world's most magnificent art collections. Tonight, join your fellow guests on the Sun Deck as your ship sets sail down the Neva River.

Day 6 Fri, 24 Jul Mandrogi (B,L,D)

Enrich

Explore this charming museum village and its distinctive buildings and perhaps try shashlik, a traditional meal similar to shish kebab.

Day 7 Sat, 25 Jul Kizhi Island (B,L,D)

Dock at Kizhi Island, an open air museum with a precious collection of wooden churches and chapels. View the Church of the Transfiguration with its 22 timbered onion domes, easily amongst the most magnificent examples of wooden architecture in Russia, if not the world.

Day 8 Sun, 26 Jul Goritsy (B,L,D)

Explore the Kirillo-Belozersky monastery, built in 1397 and home to a wonderful collection of Russian Orthodox icons. Toast the occasion with a little vodka, the beverage integral to Russian culture for over 600 years.

Day 9 Mon, 27 Jul Yaroslavl (B,L,D)

Explore the fascinating and ancient city of Yaroslavl and visit the Fine Art Museum.

Day 10 Tue, 28 Jul Uglich (B,L,D)

Explore Uglich, part of the 'Golden Ring' of cities surrounding Moscow on a guided tour.

Day 11 Wed, 29 Jul Moscow (B,L,D)

Sail towards Russia's mightiest city, Moscow. Arriving after lunch, you'll discover world-renowned sights such as Red Square and the stunningly beautiful St. Basil's Cathedral.

Day 12 Thu, 30 Jul Moscow (B,L,D)

Start your day by seeing the city's finest sights, before an insightful ride on Moscow's Metro, which is guaranteed to surprise you. After lunch in a local restaurant, enjoy free time to explore this bustling city. Tonight, you'll attend an internationally renowned Russian circus.

Day 13 Fri, 31 Jul Moscow (B,L,D)

Visit the Memorial Museum of Cosmonautics, where you'll have the opportunity to meet a real cosmonaut and learn about the history of space exploration, with original exhibits and models relating to space technology, history and art.

Enjoy a delicious lunch in a local restaurant.

Freechoice: Visit the State Tretyakov Gallery or explore the fascinating Museum of the Great Patriotic War commonly known as the World War II museum.

Day 14 Sat, 01 Aug Moscow (B,L,D)

Your day begins with a visit to the Kremlin, the intriguing seat of the former Soviet Union. Tonight, witness a thrilling Russian folk show complete with traditional costumes and dances.

Day 15 Sun, 02 Aug Moscow (B)

After breakfast, your cruise comes to an end, as all good things must, but it's also the start of a lifetime of wonderful memories.

Visa Requirements

Australian, New Zealand, Canadian, US and United Kingdom passport holders do not require visas (excluding tours that feature Russia and Turkey, where guests are required to obtain a Visa); however as visa regulations are subject to change at short notice, Scenic recommends that you contact the relevant Consulates for the latest information regarding visa requirements.

Clients must make their own enquiries regarding safety warnings and government warnings in relation to the destinations they are travelling to. These change quite regularly and can be found through your local government travel advisory. Scenic can accept no responsibility for the actions of terrorism etc in certain locations. Please refer to our terms and conditions for further advice.

Russian Invitation Letter

Guests travelling to Russia are required to supply details for the Russian Invitation Letter. This letter is issued by our Russian travel partner and is a mandatory requirement in order for the Embassy to then issue your required Visa.

For Scenic to produce your Invitation Letter you will need to provide details to us via Trip Personaliser. The required fields will be highlighted in red and will change to green once that section is successfully completed. Please complete Trip Personaliser very carefully as once information is entered and confirmed, an amendment fee will be charged to unlock Trip Personaliser and change information. Incorrect information on a Russian Invitation Letter will result in an application for a Russian visa being denied.

Once your Invitation letters have been processed you will be notified by email, providing further information regarding how to apply for your visa.

Onboard Accounts

Onboard accounts can only be settled with cash OR credit cards. Travelex cash passports and travel money will NOT be accepted.

SCENIC TSAR CABIN CATEGORIES

The 223-foot Scenic Tsar, only carrying 112 passengers and 71 crew members.

Scenic Tsar offers full-length private balconies in place of more traditional French balcony staterooms. And 93 percent of its cabins have private balconies.

Cabins located on the Volga and Neva decks have full-length private balconies

Moskva Deck (Deck 1)

Category E is a Standard Stateroom. There are 4 staterooms available located Forward on the ship. This category features a large picture window that does not open. Stateroom size is 160 square feet.

Volga Deck (Deck 2)

Category B is a Balcony Suite. There are 10 suites available located Forward. Stateroom size is 215 square feet.

Category BB is a Balcony Suite. There are 14 suites available located Aft to Midship. Stateroom size is 215 square feet.

Category BA is a Balcony Suite. There are 10 suites available located Aft. Stateroom size is 215 square feet.

Category RS is a Royal Panorama Suite. There are 2 suites (#200 and #203) available located Forward on the ship. Stateroom size is 334 square feet.

Neva Deck (Deck 3)

Category PA is a Balcony Suite. There are 6 suites available located Aft. Stateroom size is 215 square feet.

Category P is a Balcony Suite. There are 6 suites available located Midship. Stateroom size is 215 square feet.

Category R is a Royal Suite. There are 4 suites available (#302 to #304) located Forward. Stateroom size is 300 square feet.

All staterooms feature flat-panel televisions, safes, wireless internet access, complimentary minibars, L'Occitane bath amenities, hairdryers, plush bathrobes, and Scenic's own "Scenic Slumber Beds," featuring crisp Egyptian linens.

Gratuities, on board and ashore, are included on all Scenic Cruises. Complimentary wine, beer, spirits, specialty coffees, teas and soft drinks.
