Speaker: Fruita Policeman, Tony Gianinetti, gave a talk about issues in Fruita and the subdivision that the Home Owners should be aware of. The City of Fruita has appointed a new code enforcement officer. Recreational vehicles can be parked no longer than 12 hours on city streets. Police can give them a warning to move the vehicle within 48 hours or be towed. The RV cannot just be move it a few feet.

Minutes of the April 11, 2018 Quarterly meeting were presented and were approved by the membership in attendance.

Financials were presented by Ed R. Questions were asked and answered. The financials are moving from a cash basis to an accrual basis. The association is financially sound and unpaid assessments continue to be reduced.

ACC Committee: Robert Handford, chair of the ACC committee presented a new form and procedure. Shed construction were discussed. City of Fruita building codes for placement. Color, building material and size will still need to be approved by the ACC Committee.

Covenant Violation Enforcement: We have two new volunteers that drive the subdivision about twice a month to review violations. There is a new procedure in place to track violations, and the subsequent fines if any, more efficiently.

Old Business:

Keith S. discussed with the membership:

- The new subdivision signs will be about \$3,500 each. The board will discuss if something different can be done.
- City of Fruita has relaid all of the flagstones on the north end of Prospector Park.
- The board is working with the city to replace the park benches. The park is owned by the city.
- At this time there will be no sign at the park.

Jim J. has been working on a Neighborhood Watch Program. He has registered Comstock Estates on the national website. A discussion ensued, and this program will continue to be researched.

New Business:

A home owner notified the meeting that the bushes in both round-a-bouts need to be trimmed. Lori will call for that work to be done.
