## BY LAWS OF THE Apostolic Faith Bible College, Inc.

### Article VII

#### Doctrine

It is recognized that the true church of Jesus Christ consists of all believers who believe in the saving grace of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and who have accepted Him as their personal Savior. It is recognized and agreed that no organization or man has been granted authority by the Lord to exclude from or accept anyone into the Kingdom of Heaven, as this is done by Jesus Christ only. It is further recognized and agreed that we as Christians are to love all members of the Body of Christ (Christians), and this love and fellowship derives from the unity instilled by the Holy Spirit. Although differences in doctrinal beliefs and interpretations should not influence our love for one another, adherence to similar doctrinal beliefs and modes of worship have bonded together those of the Apostolic Faith Movement as founded by Charles F. Parham in the early 1900's. The scripture teaches us to adhere to the truth and proper doctrine. The common doctrinal beliefs are essentially as follows.

- \* Triune God; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit
- \* Creation and Formation
- \* Man is basically sinful and in need of salvation
- \* Salvation by Grace upon repentance toward God and acceptance of Jesus Christ as one's personal Savior, which is the conception of Spiritual Life
- \* Sanctification of the Spirit, Soul, and Body, A second definite work of Grace by the Lord Jesus Christ
- \* Baptism of the Holy Spirit; evidenced by the speaking in other languages.
- \* Water Baptism (of all believers) by immersion in water in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit
- \* Sacrament of the Lord's Supper
- \* Washing of feet
- \* Divine Healing through Jesus Christ for all believers
- \* Do not condone divorce and remarriage
- \* Destruction of the wicked
- \* Conditional Immortality
- \* Rapture of the Man Child Class
- \* Return of Jesus Christ to earth again; bodily and visibly
- \* A ministry supported by tithes and offerings

These doctrines shall be adhered to in the teachings of the Apostolic Faith Bible College, which in addition to other doctrinal teaching approved by the Board from time to time if the are not inconsistent with the above listed basic doctrines.

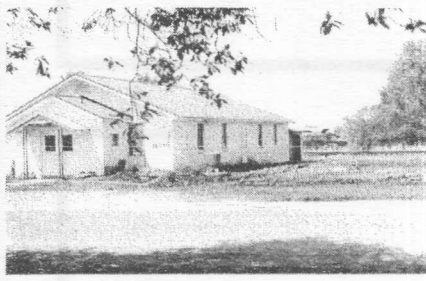

## Open House Celebration

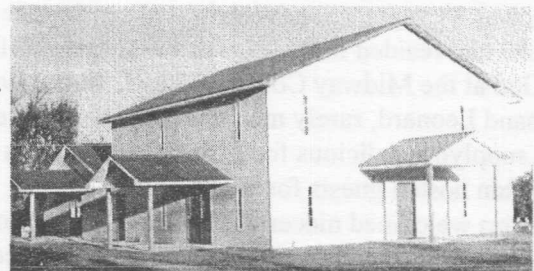

## Frances Elston

1920-2004

Funeral services were held Wednesday, December 8, 2004 for Frances Elston at the Midway Country Church, Logan, Oklahoma. Rev. Lowell Long and Rev. Jack Cornell conducted the memorial service. Burial was in the Beaver Memorial Cemetery, Beaver, Oklahoma.

Frances was 84 years, seven months and six days at her death in the local hospital, having suffered a fall two weeks earlier. She had resided in the Beaver, Ok. Nursing Home for several months due to her health. She was a faithful servant of God at the Midway Country Church since giving her heart and life to the Lord in 1949 at that church. She and Her husband Leonard, rarely missed attending services there and she did her share of helping in the ministry of feeding the sick, supplying delicious food for funeral dinners and helping with DVBS. Frances May Casteel was born May 7, 1920 to Robert L. (Bob) and Verna (Ranseyer) Casteel in Marshall, Ok. Her sister, Alice and parents lived in Beaver County on the north side of Highway 270 at the Darrouzett, TX. road after coming to the Panhandle area in 1923. She attended the Twin Mound and Sand Creek country schools. She attained an eighth grade diploma. Part of her young years were lived with her Uncle Charlie and Aunt Gladys Klepper who was a teacher.

Frances worked out in the community cleaning houses and doing odd jobs. It was while she was working in Darrouzett that she met a handsome, black haired young man wearing a bright red shirt. They fell in love and were married Jan. 10, 1940 at Woodward, Ok. They had celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary Jan. 10, 2000. Leonard died June 23 of that year.

The couple moved from their country home to Beaver in 1992. Through the years their home was always the center of extended family gatherings. Leonard's brothers and sisters, nieces and nephews enjoyed being there for holiday dinners and celebrations and many Sunday meals. Frances knew how to make them all feel loved and welcome. She was truly a help mate, working hard helping Leonard with tractor and truck driving, milking cows, feeding chickens, other farm chores and keeping a clean, tidy home for their family.

Glenn S. Turner passed from this life on Jan. 25, 2005 at the age of 100 years and 65 days. He had resided at the Joplin, Mo. Health Care for the past three years, previously residing at 810 McKinley, Joplin, Mo. next door to his son, Billie Turner. He was preceded in death by his wife of 56 years, Iva Moore Turner. To this union was born two sons, Darrell G. and Billie L. Turner.

He was an employee of ICI American (Atlas Powder Co.) retiring after 32 years of service. He was a faithful member of the Apostolic Faith Church of Prosperity, Mo for the past several years. He and his wife, Iva, had attended the Church in the Wildwood, Joplin, Mo. He is survived by his sons, Billie L. and wife Betty, Joplin, Mo. and Darrell G. and wife, Helen, Independence, Mo.; four granddaughters, Glenda Cloud and husband Terry, Webb City, Mo. Cindy Turner and Marcia Turner of Joplin, Mo., and Jennifer McGlathery and husband, Jim of Independence, Mo.; one grandson, David Turner and wife, Karen of Alvin, TX.; nine great grandchildren and six great great grandchildren. We were able to photograph his latest great-great grandchild, the son of Tara Cloud Clark and Ryan Clark with him for a five generation picture shortly before he was hospitalized.

Funeral services were held Jan. 29, 2005 at Parker Mortuary, Joplin, Mo. with Rev. Wayne Wheeler, Rev. Jim McGlathery and David Turner officiating. The funeral service was a joyous occasion celebrating his going home to be with the Lord, which had been the desire of his heart for the past two years as his health declined. His grandson, David Turner gave a wonderful eulogy of his grandfather's life. Music was provided by his grandchildren, Jennifer and Jim McGlathery and daughter Rachel. The graveside services were conducted by Rev. Jim McGlathery with Karen Turner and Amanda Beyerlein singing "Amazing Grace". One of our best memories of Dad was his testimony. You did not visit with him very long until he would say at the top of his voice "He's still the King of Kings and Lord of Lords and He is coming again!" This testimony was on his lips as we admitted him for his final stay at the hospital.

### Glenn Turner's Eulogy

At memorial services family, friends and acquaintances gather to reminisce about the one who has "passed on". These are times of sadness marked with bouts of joy and laughter as we rehearse the stories of that person's life. Accomplishments as well as failures are mentioned in connection with those still living and those who have preceded our departed family member. What we discover is that everyone is unique. Every person has a story or several stories. And somehow, somewhere, everyone fits. From the renowned to the anonymous, we all have a story. A famous American from the 60's once suggested that every man should have his 15 minutes of fame. But he probably was talking about the "beautiful people" and my grandfather was probably not one of those people.

As far as I know, Glenn S. Turner never was known much beyond this small gathering of friends and family here today. Or, maybe, he was and we just didn't recognize it, for you see, there is none of his "true contemporaries" at this gathering. A few years back when my maternal grandmother, Laura Burrows, passed away we were gathering at Lowell, Ks. just after graveside services for her. Grandpa Turner had come to the cemetery to pay his last respects for an old friend. In the cemetery, I saw him standing alone and watched and listened as my Uncle Darrell put his arm on his shoulder and asked if he was o.k. What I heard him reply that day are some of the saddest words I have ever heard another person say. He said, "They're all gone". "Who's all gone Dad?" "My friends. All my friends are gone. They have all died." You see he was the last one of his generation. Such is the plight of those who live along time. And the amazing thing about this little episode was that it took place almost 17 years ago!

So, what do we make of this? I think it is fitting to put this man's life in perspective. He was a true citizen of the 20th Century. Here's what I mean;

Glenn Turner was born to Clay and Addie Turner on Nov. 20, 1904 on the James River. He lived for 100 years and 65 days. In his lifetime the world changed more than in any period of time.

When he was born, Teddy Roosevelt was president of the United States. By the way there were only 45 stars on the American flag and digging of the Panama Canal had just begun. That year ice cream cones and iced tea were introduced to the American public and the very first section of the NYC Subway System was opened. Oklahoma was added to the Union becoming the 46th state when Grandpa was 3 years old. Oklahoma, Arizona, New Mexico, Alaska and Hawaii were all added in his lifetime. He was 4 years old when Henry Ford developed and sold the first Model T automobile for \$850. He was 5 when plastic was invented! When he was 8 years of age, the Senate voted to set an 8 hour work day for federal employees. The Titanic struck an iceberg and sunk that year too. Also, as an 8 year old boy he traveled by train with his mom and dad and little sister to Rifle, Co. They were on their way to California to do irrigation work and this was the first stop. They planted a field and sold crops and some hogs to raise money to purchase teams and equipment to finish the trip. Grandpa rode the rest of the way to Imperial Valley, Ca. in a covered wagon. He told of going through what is now Phoenix, AZ. and seeing no more than a dozen tar paper shacks. He saw bands of Indians who followed after them begging for "prohibited beverages". These were some of his earliest memories.

Grandpa also told us of riding the train back to eastern Oklahoma. This train took the southern route and apparently it was about the time in American history when we were warring with Mexico and Pancho Villa. American troops rode on the train to protect it in its journey. Grandpa was alive before Congress levied an Income Tax. Imagine that! He was older than taxes! He was 10 years old when W.W.I broke out in Europe. Only then it was called "The Great War".

He was 35 and had a family when W.W.II started. And get this: George Washington Carver was still alive when Grandpa was a boy. So were John D. Rockefeller, Thomas Edison and Pancho Villa. And the Wright Brothers! He was 13 when Lenin led a revolution that would turn Russia into the USSR. And Grandpa was still alive to see it all come tumbling down with the Iron Curtain over 70 years later in 1989. He was 22 when Charles Lindbergh flew the Spirit of St.Louis across the Atlantic Ocean and landed in Paris. He lived long enough to see men not only fly from Kitty Hawk, but also from Cape Canaveral and land on the moon. Television was also unveiled to the public when he was 22 but no one knew what to do with it for two more decades. Obviously he was alive when radio was introduced.

He was 25 when the Stock Market crashed and the Great Depression of the 1930's consumed the land along with the great dust storms. He worked building railroads and roads under the WPA like so many other Americans of that era did. He worked as a roughneck in the oilfields of NE Oklahoma as well. He worked the remainder of his lifetime at Atlas Powder Company making TNT and drew his pension longer than he worked. Glenn Turner had 19 different Presidents in his lifetime. They were Roosevelt, Taft, Wilson, Harding, Cleveland, Coolidge, Hoover, FDR, Truman, Eisenhower, Kennedy, LBJ, Nixon, Ford, Carter, Reagan, Bush, Clinton and another Bush.

The Dust Bowl of 1934 as well as escapades of Bonnie and Clyde and John Dillinger all occurred during this man's lifetime. In his lifetime he saw men go from horse drawn conveyances to modern automobiles; from walking to actually flying; from oil lamps to electric lights in every building in the nation; from visiting with your neighbors on the front porch to watching television in your front room. Things that are commonplace to us, at one time in his life, were not even dreamed of. Make no mistake, this man lived through a lot.

So, Glenn Turner's 15 minutes of fame is right now. No, he'll never be remembered by anyone else but us. He will never be the answer to some trivia question about our country's history. His name will never appear on the pages of some history book as far as I know. But, there is one book that does contain his name: the Lamb's Book of Life. I know that his name is inscribed there. And it is that one simple fact of faith that gives us joy and comfort when we grieve and miss him. And so we say, "So long".

As I conclude, the words of Noah Smithwick, a young man who fought and lived and grew up in Texas during the early days of the Texas Revolution, might be appropriate when, at the end of his life at age 92, he wrote:

So few of my old time friends have kept pace with me, that in thinking them over, I indeed, "Feel like one who treads alone, Some banquet hall deserted: Whose lights are fled, whose garlands dead, And all but he departed."

And now that He has departed, we say, "So long, Dad, Grandpa. We will miss you, but we will see you again some day".
