A parade route (to be determined) will be designed for Ride participants

All Ride participants will remain in their respective cars for the duration of the Ride

Each vehicle can make a free will donation to Relay For Life (American Cancer Society) if they choose to do so

- The Forest City Police Department will lead the Ride
- There will be a definite beginning and ending to the Ride route
- KIOW Radio is our Corporate Partner in this event- ALL vehicles should have their radios tuned to KIOW, 107.3 FM  
KIOW Radio will
  - share the names of businesses in Winnebago County who have donated corporate sponsorships
  - share further information about the American Cancer Society, its programs that serve cancer patients, and ways that donations can be made to support these programs
  - play taped interviews of cancer survivors and Relay volunteers before the Ride begins at 8:00 pm
  - read the names from Luminary donations (To Honor or Remember cancer patients) at 9:00 pm
- Vehicles in the Ride may display signs to Honor or Remember loved ones who have had or are fighting cancer
- Pyro Pete's Fireworks will have a fireworks display at 9:30 pm from Pammel Park (Hwy 69) to end the Relay activities

Opportunities are being discussed on ways to donate and display luminaries that evening  
Other plans are being created to support this event and encourage participation in the Fight Against Cancer
