## Ohio Quad City Challenge

Por 11 years now, there has been a one-day challenge between four Ohio cities. The event takes place the day after the Buckeye Open in Columbus, this year on Nov. 24.

Prior to this date, each city puts together an all-star team of 24 men and 12 women to try to bring home the coveted trophy.

Each city has at least one coordinator to put together qualifiers for players to earn the chance to represent their proud city. For example, in Cincinnati, we held qualifiers for approximately six weeks at local pubs and taverns throughout the city, keeping the opportunity open to all interested darters.

As this year's head coordinator for Cincy, I felt the overall morale of darters was high. We got interest from some of the veteran darters, which made everyone feel proud to be a part of this team. Everyone believed in each other enough to show great support for the extremely skilled players we have in this city as well as all of Ohio. We're all aware of the talent each city has, particularly Cleveland, who has won the title for the last five years.

The Quad City Challenge currently seats Cincinnati, Cleveland, Columbus and Dayton.

The 36 men and women are split into teams of four. The men's division is divided into colors (Red 1&2, Blue 3&4, Green 5&6). Each number is a team of four players. Once in your respective color, you shoot against the other cities of your color (a total of six rounds for men). The women shoot against all three teams of four players from each city (a total of nine rounds).

Each match is worth five points total. The format includes one game of 601 (all four players) and two games of 501 (splitting into doubles teams and playing each of the other pairs). If you sweep a round, you get five

points; otherwise, each game is worth one point.

After each round of play, the tournament director shows each team's score. He totals it every two rounds and shows it combined with the women's score for the city's total score. As the day goes on, you can see where you stand round by round, and decide if you need to play subs or not and where to play them.

This year, after all the totals were complete, Cincinnati came out victorious by a total of 21 pts.! The women won by 2 pts. overall, and the men by 19 pts. It was a very solid and convincing win for Cincinnati.

I'm certain that if more states would hold challenges, it would raise the interest and skill level among us all. Plus, as Ohio champions, we could challenge other state champs within the region—the possibilities are limitless. It's
