

New Vienna City Council Meeting  
August 6, 2019

Mayor Pat Hermsen opened the meeting at 5:34pm. Present were council members: Jim Naber, and Roger Langel, T.J. Kloser, Mike Leuchs at 5:46 pm., Absent-Engelken.

Naber made the motion to approve the amended agenda for August 6, 2019 by adding the Resolution #19-2019, seconded by Engelken.

Kloser made the motion to approve the consent agenda which consisted of minutes from June meetings, bills, receipts, financial reports, second by Naber.

The council reviewed the scope of service from Fehr Graham on the water pressure project, Langel made the motion to approve the agreement, second by Naber. Ayes-all.

Community center update, the discussion tonight included flooring. The windows are going to be finished this week, parking lot is graded, drywall is mostly finished. The forms will be getting set for the curb and gutter.

Payment request # 3 for Beck Construction for the amount of \$177,110.40 was approved on a motion from Kloser, second by Naber. Ayes-all.

Water and Sewer report was presented by Mike Neuhaus, nothing new to report, everything is running well

Building permit for Tractor Pullers for an addition to the press box area was approved by a motion from Kloser, second by Naber. Ayes-all. Building permit for Josh Yager was tabled until next meeting to get more information.

Liquor license for the Labor Day picnic was approved on a motion from Kloser, second by Langel. Ayes-all.

Naber made the motion to approve the agreement with US Cellular for equipment to be placed in town for better service, second by Langel. Ayes-all.

The city has received some complaints on noise from CJ Tire at 2am, residents stated that work is being done late into the night at this business and very loud noises waking them up. The Mayor will visit with the business.

The council discussed the Local Option Sales Tax Ballet and will be looking into changing the allocations of this to lawful purpose of the city to be used to help pay the loan for the new facility being built. Currently the ballet is 50% streets, 50% sewer. The new allocation will be on the November election ballet for approval. Langel made the motion to approve resolution #19-2019 A RESOLUTION OF SPECIFIC PURPOSE: 2019 LOCAL OPTION TAX PROPOSITION, second was made by Naber. Ayes-all. Absent-Engelken.

There being no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned on a motion from Leuchs, second by Langel at 6:32pm.
