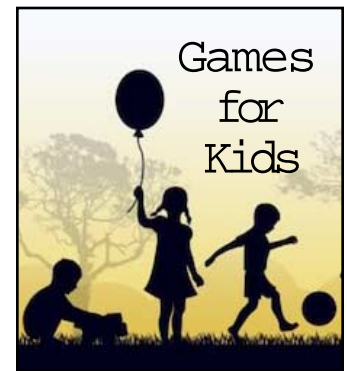

**May 15 Robert Tyhet** brother **Billy** passed away.

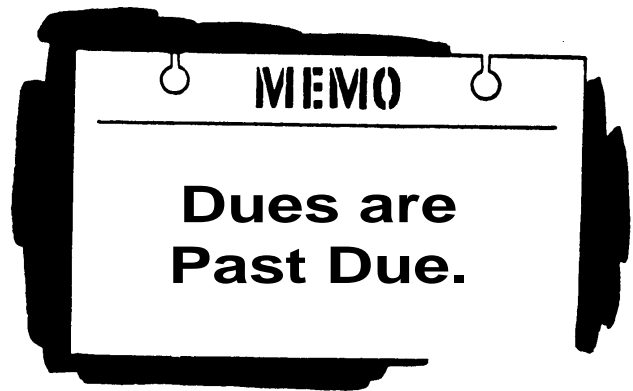
**June 3 Beverly Baker**, wife of Jerry Baker fell, serious injuries, had 11 metal staples in back of her head, face injuries also.
