NEW FOR 2017

Made two divisions in each 9 ball category-Standard/Open in Div 1 & Advanced/Elite in Div 2.

Four BEF sponsored Junior's Divisions have been added – 2 each for boys and girls.

Two Scotch Doubles tournaments if interest but the second one is limited to 32 players.

Diveney Cues is sponsoring the Advanced Division.

Made Men's and Women's races the same for singles.

Late fees have been added and they are stiff penalties.

Some Elite rules have been added.

Standard Division will follow same rules and the rest of the divisions on the 4% will move up to Open Division.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

All Singles and Teams entries are pre-registered. Enclose entry fee with form. Postmark your entry by Saturday, October 14, 2017. ACS WILL CHARGE A 5% PROCESSING FEE FOR ALL CREDIT CARD ENTRIES. *Late fees for Singles is \$15 and for Teams is \$40.*

QUALIFICATIONS TO ENTER

Player must have played a minimum of four full matches over a minimum of four (4) weeks in one session of any pool league sanctioned by the ACS within Iowa or an Iowa border state since 11/1/2016. Any four players from the same league who meet these participation requirements may compose a 4-person team. If any team has more than one Open player on its roster, the team must enter the Open division (Standard Player = ISPA Open without ever cashing; no out-of-state players allowed.). If any team has more than one national or state Advanced (ISPA Master 1, Masters, Grandmasters, or Elite) player on its roster, the team must enter the Advanced Team division. (Advanced Player = ACS, BCAPL, VNEA National, Advanced or Master; any State Master from any state list, including Iowa ACS, ISPA, IOMA, and ACS, BCAPL, Midwest, & VNEA; or "Known Ability".) **CREDIBLE AND VERIFIABLE STATS MUST ACCOMPANY EACH ENTRY! MISREPRESENTATION OF STATS WILL BE GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION!**

WOMEN'S STANDARD SINGLES: \$50 Entry fee -- race to 4

WOMEN'S OPEN SINGLES: \$60 Entry Fee--Race to 5

WOMEN'S ADVANCED SINGLES: \$75 Entry Fee--Race to 6 (Advanced)/8 (Elite)

WOMEN'S 9-BALL SINGLES: \$40 Entry Fee paid on-site—**Division 1** Race to 4 (Standard)/ 5 (Open); **Division 2** Race to 6 (Advanced)/8 (Elite)

WOMEN'S STANDARD TEAMS: \$160 Entry fee --Teams with ALL STANDARD players race to 7--Teams with maximum of 1 Open player race to 9

WOMEN'S OPEN TEAMS: \$160 Entry fee --Teams with ALL Open players race to 9--Teams with maximum of 1 Advanced player race to 11

WOMEN'S OPEN TEAMS – 2nd-CHANCE: \$40 Entry fee paid on-site --Race to 9 -- Single Elimination, must have 3 of the original players (A Standard Team may play in the Open 2nd Chance also with a Race to 7)

WOMEN'S ADVANCED TEAMS: \$240 Entry fee--Teams with two (2) or more Advanced and/or Elite players race to 13

MEN'S STANDARD SINGLES: \$50 Entry fee-- race to 4

MEN'S OPEN SINGLES: \$60 Entry Fee --Race to 5

MEN'S ADVANCED SINGLES: \$75 Entry Fee--Race to 6 (Advanced)/8 (Elite)

MEN'S 9-BALL SINGLES: \$40 Entry Fee paid on-site—**Division 1** Race to 4 (Standard)/5 (Open); **Division 2** Race to 6 (Advanced)/8 (Elite)

MEN'S/MIXED STANDARD TEAMS: \$160 Entry fee--Teams with ALL STANDARD players race to 7--Teams with maximum of 1 Open player race to 9

MEN'S/MIXED OPEN TEAMS: \$160 Entry fee --Teams with ALL Open players race to 9--Teams with maximum of 1 Advanced player race to 11

MEN'S/MIXED OPEN TEAMS - 2nd-CHANCE: \$40 Entry fee on-site --Race to 9 -- Single Elimination, must have 3 of the original players (A Standard team may play in the Open 2nd Chance also with a Race to 7)

MEN'S/MIXED ADVANCED TEAMS: \$240 Entry fee--Teams with two (2) or more Advanced and/or Elite players race to 13

JUNIORS (BEF Sponsored): \$25 Entry Fee Plus \$10 if not BEF Sanctioned – Boys 14 & Under; Boys 18 & Under; Girls 14 & Under, Girls 18 & Under

SCOTCH DOUBLES 8-BALL: \$30 Entry fee paid on-site--Any man/woman team who meet singles entry qualifications--Race to 3 (If no Open or Advanced)/ Race to 4 (If no Advanced or Elite)/ Race to 5 (with maximum 1 Advanced or Elite)

Races in ALL divisions will be subject to change according to number of entries. There will be no scheduling conflicts between singles divisions and team divisions. Players may compete in both divisions. OPEN TABLES – GREENS FEES DEDUCTED: \$15 –Singles entry/ \$40 –Teams entry /No greens fees deducted from second-chance events!

DRESS CODE

- Dress code must meet the Singles competition requirements in all divisions.
