**DID YOU KNOW?**

In 2013, ASHRAE changed some WV counties to a different climate zones. Most of WV is now in CZ 4. Only the NE part of the state stayed in CZ 5. This reflects the warmer climate. WV 90.1-2007 Code says these transition areas can design for CZ 5 but the latest 90.1-2016 Standard has them in CZ 4. Your call as a designer which one you use. Code CZ5 or "Real" CZ4.
