

Directions for Teddy Bear Hats and Scarves --2009

Directions for Hat: Size 8 needles Worsted weight 4-ply yarn

Cast on 45 stitches. Work in ribbing (knit 1 stitch, purl 1 stitch) for 6 rows.
Work in stockinette stitch (knit 1 row, purl 1 row) for 4-1/2 inches above ribbing, ending with a purl row. (approximately 24 rows)
Decrease 1 stitch at end of the last row.

Begin decreases ... Row 1: Knit 1, knit 2 tog (knit 2, k2 tog) 10 times, knit 1 -- 32 stitches remain.
Row 2 and all even rows -- purl across
Row 3: Knit 2, k 2 tog across entire row. -- 8 stitches decreased and 24 stitches remain.
Row 5: Knit 1, k2 tog across entire row -- 8 stitches decreased and 16 stitches remain.
Row 7: Knit 2 together across entire row -- 8 stitches decreased and 8 stitches remain.
Row 9: Knit 2 together across entire row -- 4 stitches decreased and 4 stitches remain.
Row 11: Knit 2 together across entire row -- 2 stitches decreased and 2 stitches remain.
Fasten off by drawing yarn through remaining 2 stitches and pulling up yarn to close stitching.

Weave side edges together. Add 1 inch pompom to top of hat.

Directions for Scarf: Size 9 needles Worsted weight 4 ply yarn

Cast on 8 stitches. Rows 1 through 4 -- knit each row.
Row 5: With each stitch, wrap yarn around needle twice and knit the stitch. (This creates a very loose stitch for the pattern.)
Rows 6 through 9 - knit each row.
To continue in pattern ... Repeat the KNIT WRAP AROUND ROW, KNIT EVEN FOR 4 ROWS.
Continue this pattern 17 more times for a total of 19 wrap around rows and 20 of the knit 4 rows.
Bind off.
Using 10" lengths of yarn and crochet hook, fasten fringe on each end of scarf. Trim fringe even.

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
