Progressive reformers included political leaders like Robert Lafollette, Theodore Roosevelt, William Howard Taft, and Woodrow Wilson, social reformers like Ida B. Wells, W.E.B. Dubois, Jane Addams and Alice Paul, and muckraking journalists like Ida Tarbell, Lincoln Steffens, Jacob Riis, and Upton Sinclair. During the Progressive Era, they exposed ills of society caused by rapid industrialization, urbanization, and other issues of inequity and inequality and worked to reform American society.
