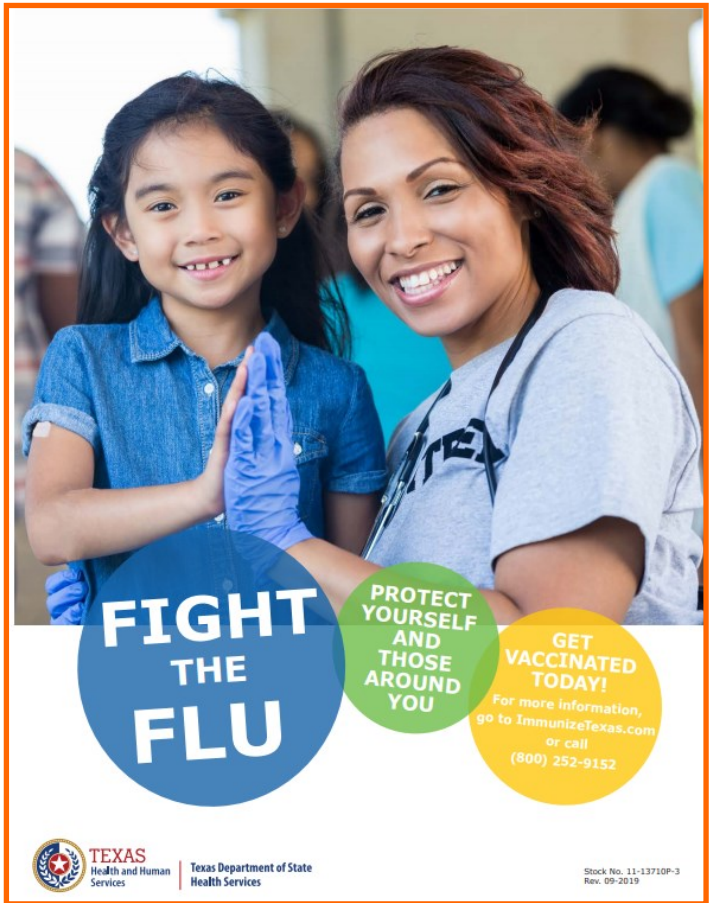

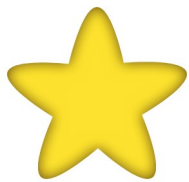
Who was Maria Montessori?

Maria Montessori was an Italian physician and educator. She believed that all children would have the opportunity to be taught no matter their family background. It all began in the low-income area of Rome. In the basement of an apartment building, Maria Montessori and volunteers would watch children while the parents worked. They would help the children with life skills such as bathing, combing their hair, and cleaning up. After much research, she opened the first Casa dei Bambini (Children's House). Ms. Linda also has a similar vision incorporating bilingual teaching with the old-fashioned Montessori method.
