All the items must be delivered to the Community Center on Thursday, April 12, 2018 between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. You will be given a receipt for each item entered into the show.

Items entered in the show will be available for pickup at the show entrance on April 14th from 6-6:45 p.m. A receipt must be presented to pick up your entry.

Handcrafts Unlimited's Georgetown Quilt & Stitchery Show Committee appreciates your interest in our upcoming show and your willingness to share your treasures!

Please fill out the attached form and return it to:

- Handcrafts Unlimited at 104 West 8th St. (on Georgetown's historic square)
- Along with a mandatory picture of your entry (see below).

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. Items entered should not have been exhibited in a previous Georgetown Quilt & Stitchery Show. Entries should be made or owned by a Williamson or surrounding counties resident or a Handcrafts Unlimited artisan or volunteer.
2. Quilt or Stitchery forms may be obtained at Handcrafts Unlimited or at the Quilt Show web site at www.handcraftsunlimited.com/georgetown-quilt-show.html. The entry form may be copied.
3. Please use one form for each item entered. The completed form must be **legible**.
4. No unfinished items will be accepted for display in the show.
5. To aid in the planning of the show, a picture of your entry **MUST** accompany each entry form. Acceptable pictures include photos, scans, digital photo printouts and Polaroid's. The photo should be no larger than 4" x 6".
6. **Each entry must be placed in a pillowslip with the entrant's name, address and phone number securely attached to the back of the quilt and to the pillowslip. Entries without a pillowslip will not be accepted.**
7. **Stitchery items must have the entrant's name, address and phone number securely attached to the back of the item before delivery to the Georgetown Community Center.**
8. Make sure that the hanging hardware on your stitchery piece is securely fastened.
9. Cancellations should be made by calling Karen Purdy at 512-863-4205.
10. For security purposes, the exhibit area of the Community Center will close at 5 pm on Saturday, April 14th to allow the show committee members time to prepare the items for pickup. Receipts are required to pick up all entered items. **A representative may pick up an item in your place, but the receipt will be required to ensure that each piece in our keeping is properly returned.** We ask for patience as we carefully ensure the safekeeping of your entries. Please mark your calendar with these dates. Items will be available for pickup on **April 14th from 6 p.m. - 6:45 pm.**
11. People's Choice balloting will close at 2 pm, on April 14th. The list of winners will be posted and awards will be given out at 4:00 pm.
12. Entries will be accepted until available display space is full. Each entry form will be date-stamped with the receipt date.

A completed entry form and mandatory photo must accompany each item entered into the show. Photocopies of this form will be accepted. **Allow extra time for mailed entries to ensure receipt on or before the deadline.** All items are date stamped the day they are picked up at the Post Office and brought to the shop.
