Minutes of the Special Meeting of the Council of the Town of Preeceville held on Tuesday, April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017 in the Preeceville Town Office Council Chambers, Preeceville, Saskatchewan.

The Special Meeting of Council was called by the Town Council to meet with Cory Paul regarding water drainage issues at the elevator property and to meet with Chris Balyski regarding water drainage issues in his back alley and yard at 436 1<sup>st</sup> Street NW.

Acting Deputy Mayor Mark Bourassa called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Agenda 136-17 Newton/Bartel: That the agenda be approved. CARRIED.

7:00 pm to 7:20 pm Cory Paul met with Council to discuss his concerns regarding the Elevator property being affected by water coming from the snow piled on the west side of the Main street parking Lot. Cory explained to Council that he cannot get his grain out of the elevator as water sits in the leg of the elevator till July and that the elevator is starting to lean to the north, as the ground under the foundation is constantly saturated from the slow melt of the snow pile. Previously Council determined that the majority of the snow piled at the Main Street parking lot would be moved each year and ditching work was to be done to prevent this problem; however, Cory is now requesting that the snow all be moved and no snow piled in this area in the future.

Elevator 137-17 Bartel/Strykowski: That the remaining snow piled at the Main Street  
Water 137-17 Parking Lot be moved to the east of the elevator property by April  
Issue 137-17 7<sup>th</sup>, 2017 and that the shop crew complete more ditching work in  
this area this summer; and further that all snow put in the Main Street  
parking lot next winter will be piled on the east side of the lot with this  
matter to be reviewed in the Spring of 2018. CARRIED.

7:30 pm to 7:50 pm Chris Balyski met with Council to discuss his concerns regarding the water drainage issues in his back alley and how it is affecting his property at 436 1<sup>st</sup> Street NW. Chris explained that due to the drainage issues and poor snow removal in the back alley his yard has been flooding over the past years. On March 26<sup>th</sup>, the water in Chris's yard backed up to his house and was coming into the basement. Chris is requesting the drainage issues be fixed and he is requesting compensation for his snow removal costs and landscaping his backyard. Council determined that this matter would be further discussed at the next regular meeting of Council.
