

EDWARD L. FITZPATRICK

1917-1993

Edward L. Fitzpatrick, 75 of Bay Port, died Saturday, Jan. 16, at Bay Medical Center, Bay City, following a lengthy illness.

Mr. Fitzpatrick was born in Rich Hill, MO, Nov. 4, 1917, the son of Guy and Hannah (Vose) Fitzpatrick. He was married to Eula J. (Barrett) Harris on March 12, 1957, in Warren, and she survives him.

Mr. Fitzpatrick had been employed as a tool and die maker for Keystone Manufacturing in Warren for many years before retiring in 1975. The Fitzpatricks moved to Bay Port from Warren in 1977. He served in the U.S. Army as a tank commander during World War II. He was a member of Faith Bible Baptist Church in Bay Port.

Surviving, beside his wife Eula are one daughter and spouse, Karen Sue and Charles Kennedy of Adrian, MO; one stepson and spouse, William Joseph and Ruby Harris of McCalla, AL; one stepdaughter and spouse, Helen and Joseph Schmuck of Clinton Township; 13 grandchildren and 27 great-grandchildren.

One stepson, Charles Harris, and one sister, Sylvia Hartsell, preceded him in death.

The funeral service will take place at 11 a.m. Wednesday, Jan. 20 at Faith Bible Baptist Church, Bay Port. Rev. Rick L. Randall will officiate and burial will be in New Bay Port Cemetery.

There will be visitation at Dinkel-Juengel Funeral Home, Sebawaing, from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Tuesday (today). He will lie in state in the church from 10 a.m. Wednesday until the time of service.
