MISSION & OUTREACH COMMITTEE UPDATE

A huge thank you to everyone who donated to our May mission focus, collect-

ing funds to support the serving of a hot lunch to students at Mpangua School in Chogoria Presbytery.

Our June and July focus is collecting diapers and wipes for Churches United, to be distributed by them to families who need them. We are collecting size 5 and 6 diapers, as well as wipes. If you are unable to shop for diapers yourself, Donna and Boots will be glad to do the shopping for you. Let's get another carload collected this year!

Our August focus will again be collecting money to purchase winter wear for the schoolchildren at Bdecan. There is no school in Tokio, so the students attend Warwick, Four Winds, Devils Lake or Minnewaukan. This means that most of the students ride an hour or longer on the bus to get to school, and they are not allowed on the bus in the winter without a coat, snow pants, boots, hat and mittens. They are also not allowed outside at recess without proper attire.

At present, the Ministry Team has about \$2,500 in the clothing line item, but need at least \$6,000 to properly outfit the children of the church. We may not be able to collect the full \$3,500 needed, but let's see how close we can get. Also, if you knit or crochet, and want to make hats and/or mittens, bring them to church during August, and we will get them to Bdecan. Thank you for your support.
