Instructions for obtaining signatures

All documents must be mailed to the address listed below by May 10th 2014.

You must be 18 years of age or older, a qualified elector (elector is a voter) in Wisconsin, to sign the nomination papers and you must be 18 years of age or older to circulate nomination papers.

Each elector's municipality of residence – NOT Mailing address – must be listed on the nomination paper, including any street, fire or rural route number, box number (if rural route) and street or road name.

What to do...

- Personally present the nomination paper to each signer.
- List clearly the municipality of residence: identify the town, village or city where the elector's voting residence is located. A post office box number alone does not show where the elector actually resides.
- Make sure the date of your signature as the circulator is after the date of the latest signer.
- Make sure to write your municipality, not just your mailing address, of where you vote.
- For example, the mailing address may be a P.O. Box in Green Bay, but they vote in the Village of Howard. Please be sure to have them check the appropriate box under City, Village, or Township.
- Make sure to list your complete address, sign, and date the papers upon completion of all ten names on a sheet.
- A sheet with less than ten signatures is still good. You do not need to fill each sheet.

Things not to do..

- Do not leave the nomination paper unattended, on counters or posted on bulletin boards.
- Do not number your pages. The numbering process will be done upon collection of all papers.
- You do not have to disclose your vote when signing a nomination paper.
