In a surprise to many, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service recently rebuffed demands from a series of environmentalist groups to phase out the use of traditional ammunition and fishing tackle on public land.

The FWS, part of the Department of Interior, reports to Debra Haaland, a former Democrat lawmaker from New Mexico who was backed for her current position by well-known anti-hunting groups such as WildEarth Guardians and the HSUS. In 2022, the agency was presented with a 63-page petition from the Center for Biological Diversity – an activist organization that pro-gun groups have characterized as one that "fights against regulated sport hunting at nearly every opportunity" – to ban lead ammo and fishing gear on the more than 500 million acres of federal lands by 2024.

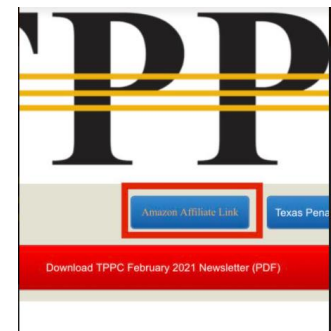
However, in news broken last week by the Association of Fish and Wildlife Agencies, FWS Director Martha Williams has decided to reject the Center for Biological Diversity's petition and not undertake a national rulemaking concerning lead ammunition and tackle on the National Wildlife Refuge System.

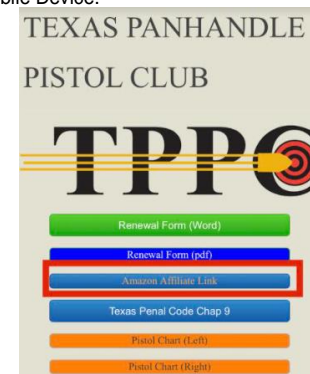

Club Dues Increase

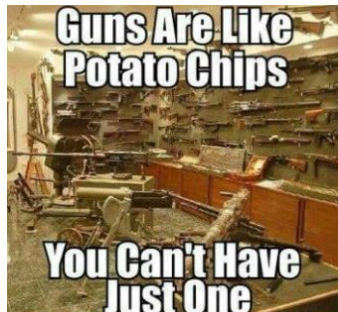
The club dues will increase \$10 per year for a total of \$120. This change will start Aug 1st. There will not be any "grandfathering" of dues for past or current members.

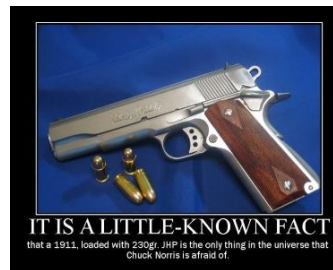

HOUSTON, Texas (KTRK) -- A man was shot by a nine-month pregnant woman and her husband after surveillance video shows him attacking the couple in front of a north Houston gas station Tuesday evening.

"No, they were not taking out my baby daddy before July 11," the woman said, referring to her due date.

The shooting happened at about 5:25 p.m. Tuesday at 8605 Fulton Street.

The couple asked ABC13 to conceal their identities, fearing retaliation. The woman said she parked in front of the All-Season Food Store on Fulton Road, near Berry, to deliver food for her husband, who works at the store. Two armed men were inside a silver SUV parked nearby.



[Court Rejects ATF Final Rule on Frames and Receivers](#)

A federal judge in the Northern District of Texas last week vacated the ATF's final "frame or receiver" rule, citing the agency didn't have the authority to establish such a mandate.

The ATF's controversial new rulemaking, which treated unfinished frames and receivers the same as if they are complete and functional firearms, took effect last August. At least two lawsuits challenging the rule in court – one by Gun Owners of America and attorneys general from 17 states and another by the Firearms Policy Coalition – unsuccessfully sought injunctions to bar the rule from taking effect. It is the FPC-backed case, *VanDerStok v. Garland*, which resulted in an order against the ATF rule.

Further, he held that the government's argument that ATF had made such sweeping rule changes in the past without Congressional approval, was flawed.

Last month's background check numbers represent nearly four years where checks for the over-the-counter sale of a firearm have exceeded 1 million in each calendar month.

The National Shooting Sports Foundation confirmed the running 47-month streak after calculating the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Instant Criminal Background Check System figures for June 2023.

The unadjusted FBI NICS total for last month stands at 2,152,187. Once the data is crunched by NSSF to remove checks and rechecks done to clear carry permits and other reasons, the number of checks for likely retail gun sales remains at 1,110,696, standing at the fifth highest seen in the month of June going back for the NICS program's 24-year history. The 1.1 million tally also continues the seven-figure benchmark that has consistently appeared in July 2019.
