SINGLE MAKER QUILT CATEGORIES – please keep in mind that in the judging process of the single maker quilts, the specific technique will be heavily considered.

- Pieced Technique** – quilt is predominately pieced
- Applique Technique** – quilt is predominately appliqued
- Mixed Technique** – quilt top consists of **both** applique and piecing in **approximately equal amount or effect**
- Other Techniques** – embroidered by hand or machine, painted, whole cloth, crazy quilt, yo-yo, photo transfer, thread painted, fabric collage, or any other technique or category that is not listed above.
- Member Challenge Quilt** (minimum 20" to maximum 20") – ELIQG Member ONLY

SPECIAL QUILTING CATEGORIES

- Beginner Quilt** – first or second quilt, entirely constructed by the maker
- Youth Quilt** – made by a Youth, age 14 and under, please state age: _____
- Duet Quilt** – quilt is created by the owner/maker and one other person. This category may include professional services such as long-arm quilting services. Please include the name below in the quilting information.
- Group Quilt** – defined as 3 or more people involved in completion of the quilt, such as, but not limited to, a Round Robin Quilt. Please list the names of all participants on the reverse side of this form.
- Kit Quilt** – defined as a quilt made from fabric selected and given to you with directions, purchased either online or in a store, and may include a Block of the Month quilt if you did not select the fabrics yourself.

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- Members and non-members of the Eastern Long Island Quilters' Guild, Inc. (ELIQG) are invited to enter quilts made using quilt making techniques. Show space is limited. Only the first 150 quilts received will be accepted. No clothing, pillows, purses quilted accessories or home decor items will be accepted.
- Members are limited to four quilts plus one Member Challenge quilt. There is an entry fee for members in good standing of \$10 to help defray the costs of judging. Make checks payable to ELIQG. Members who do not volunteer services for the Quilt Show are limited to two quilts and must pay the non-member entry fee of \$25.
- Non-Guild members are limited to two quilt entries. There is an entry fee of \$25 per non-member for one OR two quilts to help defray the costs of judging. Make checks payable to ELIQG.
- One form must be filled out for **EACH** quilt being entered. You may copy the entry form if entering more than one quilt.
- **Entry registration deadline: handed in at May 8, 2018 ELIQG meeting, or postmarked/sent no later than May 8, 2018,** by U.S Mail or hand delivered to: Lynn C. Fullshire, 32 Lower Cross, Shoreham, NY 11786.
- Unless otherwise notified the quilt being registered has been accepted into the show pending hands-on inspection at quilt delivery. If you must withdraw the quilt, notify the Quilt Registrar at least one week prior to the delivery date: Lynn Fullshire at 1-631-744-7640.
- Please credit any traditional or commercial pattern from which your quilt is made.
- Entries do not have to fit the show theme.
- Quilts must have been constructed by the person(s) named on the entry form. **Group quilts are** defined as 3 or more people involved in completion of the quilt, such as, but not limited to, a Round Robin quilt. List the names of all participants. **Duet quilts** are defined as made by the owner/maker and one other person, which may include a professional service such as a long-arm service. The name of the other person or professional service must be included in the quilting information area.

ENTRY RULES:

- Quilts must not have been previously exhibited in an ELIQG Show.
- Quilts must consist of three layers
- The Guild reserves the right, for whatever reason, to accept or reject any submitted entry.
- **Quilts MUST have a 4-inch-wide cloth casing (sleeve) securely sewn to the top back for hanging.** (If sleeve is missing or the opening is narrower than 4 inches, the quilt will not be accepted.)
- Please be aware that some quilts may be pinned to a backing sheet for display purposes. The utmost care will be taken to ensure proper support of your quilt.
- Quilts must have a label securely sewn to the back with your name, address and telephone number.
- **Exhibitors are responsible for their own insurance on their quilts while in our possession and quilts must remain on display for the entire show.**
- Please check over your quilt and make sure it is free of loose threads, animal hair, etc. All quilts must arrive clean, undamaged, and free of strong odors to be judged and shown. ELIQG reserves the right to omit an entry from judging or display if the quality or condition does not meet standards upon hands-on inspection.
- ELIQG is not responsible for embellishments on your quilt. Make sure they are well secured.
- Your signature signifies your agreement with these rules and gives permission for ELIQG to photograph your entry for local and regional use in media advertising, promotion, and publication in newspapers, magazines, internet and other appropriate media.

JUDGING:

- All quilts will be judged by a professional judge for ribbons within their category.
- ELIQG reserves the right to reassign categories as necessary to ensure fair judging.
- A BEST IN SHOW ribbon may be awarded by the judge. First, Second, Third and Merit ribbons may be awarded by the judge in each category. Viewer's Choice ribbons will be awarded to the quilts receiving the most votes for the viewing public. A Judge's Choice ribbon may be awarded by the judge.
- Any ribbon within a category may not be awarded. It is the judge's decision whether to award all prizes within a category.
- All quilts will receive a private written evaluation. Generally, quilters gain insight from receiving this feedback.

QUILT DELIVERY:

Your quilts in compliance with entry rules will be accepted in person at Suffolk Community College, Riverhead, NY, **between 3 P.M. and 7 P.M. on Tuesday, June 5, 2018** in the large dining room in the Peconic Building. You will receive your call number for hand-on inspection/turn-in, and your receipts. At this time all paperwork pertaining to your quilts will be reviewed by you, the Registrar and show committee members. The receipt will serve to claim your quilt at the close of the show.

QUILT RETURN:

All quilts must remain on display throughout the show. **When picking up your quilt, please report to the Main Lobby in the Peconic Building of Suffolk Community College, Riverhead, NY between 4:30 PM and 5 PM, Sunday, June 10th to receive your call number. No quilt will be returned without a receipt.** For the safety and protection of your quilt you must present your receipt before your quilt will be returned to you or your representative. A form of ID and signature will be required at pick-up.
