This years' One Motorcycle Show was February 8, 9, and 10th. It was the 10th anniversary and there were 18,000 attendees, 165 builders, and 200+ motorcycles on display. In addition, there were 45 artists, 54 vendors, and 24 sponsors. There were also 21 local high school artists on display. Three motorcycles were raffled for charity. Nine motorcycles from OTC were displayed. See photos in this newsletter. Jen and Tom developed the master builders list, stuffed builder SWAG bags, and greeted and checked in the builders.

Tentative plans for next year are for the show to take over the Memorial Coliseum. This will allow the bike displays, flat track racing, and motocross to all be under one roof.
