This past Sunday came time again to celebrate the



The Jams on Tap 2014 schedule features headline performances from Bret Michaels, Plain White T's and Three Dog Night. Opening acts include local favorites 5 Card Studs, I'm Not A Pilot and Vic & Gab, who recently earned a 2014 Song of the Year award from the Wisconsin Area Music Industry Awards. Afternoon performances include music from The Wisconsin Philharmonic and The Ultimate Legends Show, which highlights the hits of Buddy Holly, Johnny Cash, Neil Diamond and The Blues Brothers.
