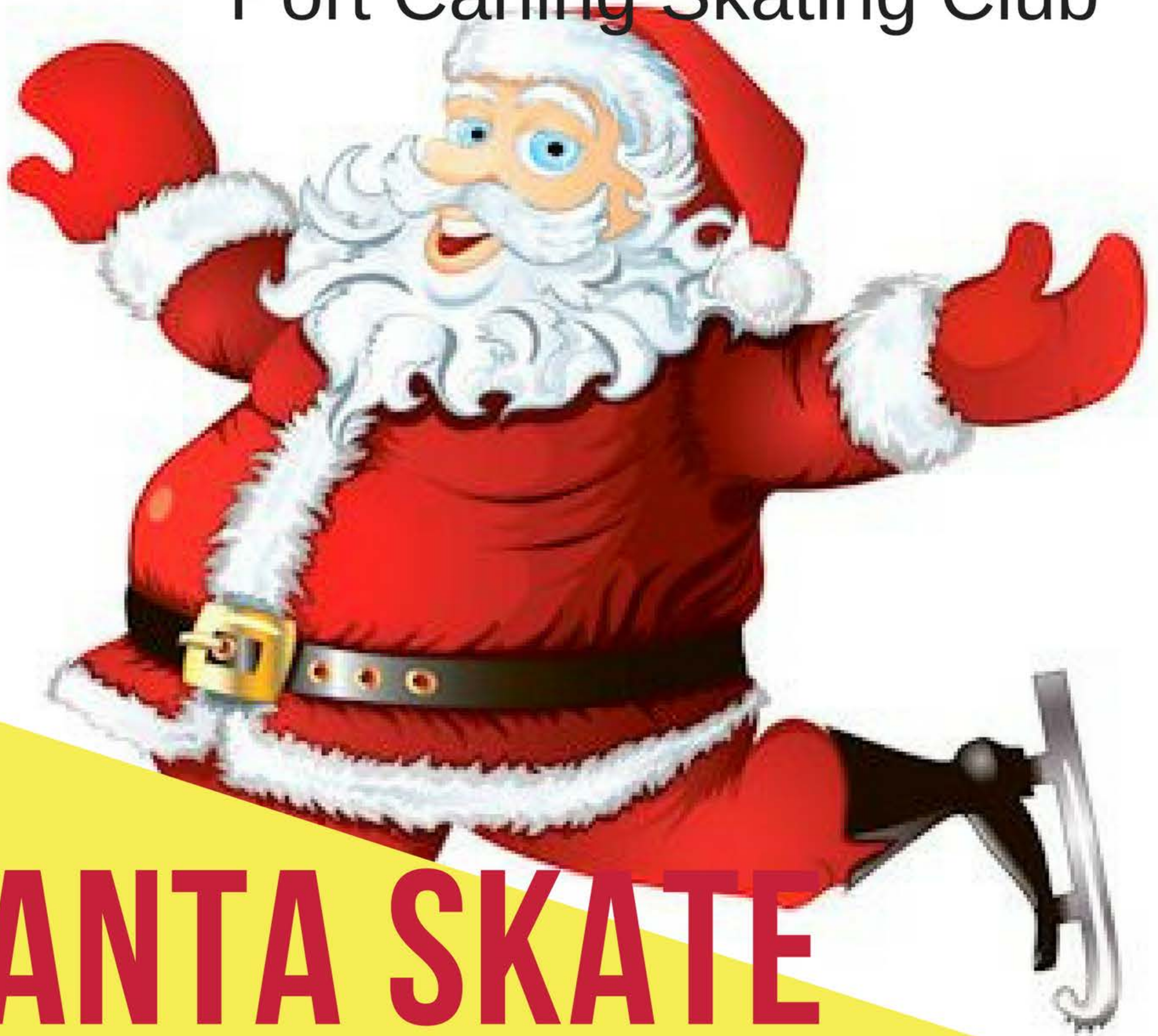

1. If you are registered for the 2018-19 season as a **COMPETITIVE SKATER**, **YOU MAY ONLY COMPETE IN OPEN EVENTS.**
2. **Skaters may register for ONE FREESKATE EVENT ONLY.**

FILING OF ENTRIES:

The TEST CHAIR or designate in each club shall be responsible for the filing of entry forms and shall SIGN EACH ENTRY FORM AND INCLUDE PHONE NUMBER, to certify that each entry has been verified as to qualifications and eligibility.

VERY IMPORTANT!!

Each CLUB shall submit their COMPLETE package as follows.

1. Each individual entry form verified with designated signature and phone number.
2. **CLUB SUMMARY** sheet of ALL entries being submitted (summary attached)
3. Team events with **COMPLETE** list of skaters
4. **ONE CLUB CHEQUE** for the total fees for all entries from your club
5. (no personal cheques will be accepted, **ONLY club cheques**).

**CLUB ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE REGISTRAR, IN HER HANDS,
NO LATER THAN 5:00 pm ON OCTOBER 31 2018**

This will enable the committee to have the schedule and group lists back to the clubs at least 10 DAYS prior to the competition. Wouldn't that be nice? Please have your entries in on time, and COMPLETE. Thank you.

NOTE: ALL EVENTS WILL RUN with 2 skaters or more.

All events with only one entry will be asked if they would like to skate an exhibition.

All groups will be kept to a maximum of 6.

We will do our best to group by age and then by club so that not too many skaters from the same club are in the same group if possible.

Each competitor is entitled to be accompanied by an accredited (photo ID MAY be requested at rink side) coach/choreographer. All competitors and their chaperones must register at the Port Carling Arena no later than **ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED START OF THEIR EVENT**. The only exception to this rule is the **FIRST EVENT OF THE DAY, WHERE THE SKATER MAY REGISTER ½ HOUR BEFORE THE SCHEDULED TIME OF THE EVENT**. If the skater is not present up to ½ hr before the scheduled time of event, the event will proceed without the missing skater. Your money **WILL NOT** be refunded unless there are extenuating circumstances or a medical slip for injury only.

PRESENTATION OF AWARDS:

Ribbons &/OR Medals will be presented at the completion of events, periodically throughout the day. The AWARDS presentations will be scheduled and will be presented in the hall upstairs at the Community Centre next to arena. All skaters in a group will receive an award/ribbon.

PROFESSIONAL COACH/CHOREOGRAPHER ACCREDITATION:

In order to be accredited at any Skate Ontario performance event, Professional Coaches and Choreographers must meet the standards for said professionals as set out in the Skate Canada Rule Book. All professional coaches shall be coaches in good standing with Skate Canada and hold a valid First Aid Certificate and carry with them their Photo ID

ALL PROFESSIONAL COACHES WHO ATTEND THE PERFORMANCE PLUS EVENT MUST WEAR THEIR PHOTO I.D. ACCREDITATION AT ALL TIMES. PLEASE COMPLY.

ICE FACILITY:

The Port Carling Ice Surface is 80x180

ADMISSION:

Children under 5 years: Free
General Admission: \$5.00 per day/ \$10.00 Day Pass.

PROGRAMS: \$2.00

MEALS AND SNACKS:

The arena canteen will be open throughout the competition. There will also be food available at the Community Center hall for all skaters and spectators to purchase.

MUSIC REGISTRATION:**GENERAL MUSIC REQUIREMENTS - INSTRUCTIONS**

CDs: Each entry must provide two CDs of the correct music for the competition upon registration, one for competition - marked "Master" and one for back up - marked "Copy". These must be registered with music registration at least one hour prior to the posted start time of the category and may not be removed for any reason until after the category is completed. CD Audio Discs are the only music format accepted. iPhones, iPods or other digital sources will not be accepted as backups. Music must be picked up within 30 minutes after completion of the category.

All music used must be in the public domain or covered by the performing rights societies. Competitors who have music composed specifically for their programs either wholly or in part, are responsible for obtaining a written release from the composer for the use of such music on radio and/or television or appropriate clearance from the performing rights societies

Standard Specifications for Music:

- (1) Only one program shall be recorded on each CD
- (2) Competitor's name followed by home club, category, program type-short or free and music time shall be printed on front of the CD label using a black Sharpie pen
- (3) Each CD shall be enclosed in a plastic case in good repair marked with the skater's name, home club, category, program type – short or free, and total music time

Technical Guidelines for Music CDs:

- (1) Music on CD must be burned in CD Audio Format (NOT mp3;.acc or DVD)
- (2) Music should be burned on CD-R discs of good quality that provide legible space for the skater information to be printed on
- (3) It is recommended that CDs be burned at speeds 16Xs or less
- (4) The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in

Mary wants to compete in STAR 4 Freeskate, interpretive, elements, spins and on a team.

Here is the breakdown:

\$55.00(1st event freeskate) +
 \$30.00 (2nd event interpretive)+
 \$20.00 (3rd event elements) +
 \$10.00(4th event spins) =
 \$115.00

Plus 1/4 of the cost of a 4's team fee which is \$6.00.

So the grand total for Mary is \$121.00 for a weekend of skating fun!!

- b) Skaters shall not possess or use alcohol in any form or have alcohol within the immediate area of the arena, ice surface. Etc., or hotel accommodations. Furthermore, skaters shall not supply such substances to others.
- c) Any damage to property shall be assessed to the person causing willful damage.
- d) Athletes shall conduct themselves at all times in a reasonable and acceptable manner.
