Long Course: 10.5 miles (Orange)



A few modifications for 2021:

- **The Presidio Yacht Club cannot be accessed on the day of the race.**
- **Paddlers are asked to bring their own food and drink.** We will not be serving lunch.
- **BBQs are not allowed at the race,** due to the current drought and fire season.
- No tents along the waterfront. Club tents will be set up on the other side of the road. Tents cannot be staked down. Please bring sand bags or other weights. (see Map)
- No parking along break wall. (see map)
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the site.

Directions : Enter “US Coast Guard Station, Golden Gate” into your GPS!



From Northbound Hwy 101, after crossing the Golden Gate Bridge:

- Alexander exit (first exit off bridge after vista point/lookout area)
- First LEFT onto Bunker (Look for the Fort Baker sign on your right)
- Follow directions below from Bunker Road.

From Southbound Hwy 101:

- 101 S to SAUSALITO exit -last exit before GG bridge
- Turn RIGHT at stop off exit
- First LEFT onto Bunker (Look for the Fort Baker sign on your right)

From East Bay via 880N or 580N:

- 880N to 580N to Sir Francis Drake Blvd (Exit 2A)
- From Larkspur, take 101 S on ramp
- 101 S to SAUSALITO exit -last exit before GG bridge
- Turn RIGHT at stop off exit
- First LEFT onto Bunker (Look for the Fort Baker sign on your right)

Once on Bunker Road East:

- First RIGHT onto Bunker Road East before tunnel (do not enter tunnel)
- Downhill, RIGHT at stop onto Murray Circle
- At next stop sign, stay to the RIGHT to Moore Road
- Immediate LEFT, by eucalyptus tree, onto Sommerville (Coast Guard on left, SF Bay on right)
