Please provide your original documentation at check-in for entry into the show hall. As Franklin County requires a rabies vaccination for a ferret to be legal, we will be checking the rabies vaccination records for each ferret entering the show hall. All ferrets at an AFA show must provide proof of negative Aleutian's Disease Virus (ADV) testing within 12 months of the show date. Testing must be by the Blue Cross Animal Hospital's CEP test or the Avecon ELISA (saliva) Test and results must be:

- 1) on tester's original letterhead;
- 2) testing date must be on the letter and within the stated period;
- 3) ferret names must be on the testing result's letter and names must match show entry.

A letter from your vet is NOT ACCEPTABLE. Faxes or copies are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Notarized copies with raised seal are acceptable.

ADV Waiver Statement

The following waiver must be signed by each person bringing ferrets into an AFA sanctioned or AFA show hall. (Forms are available in the show packet for each AFA sanctioned event).

No ferret that I am bringing with me into the show hall today has ever had a definitive positive test result on the United CEP.

If in the past 4 months a ferret from my household (shelter/facility/ferretry) has had a definitive positive test result on the Blue Cross Animal Hospital CEP, I understand that all ferrets in the same household (shelter/facility/ferretry) are considered as being exposed. I also understand that I cannot show or bring any ferrets from said household into the show hall today, regardless of their testing status.

I also understand that just because all ferrets in the show hall today have been tested for ADV within the 12 months prior to the show, that this is not a guarantee of safety. I understand that the test is only as good as the day it was taken and I still need to practice SAFE FERRET habits at all times.

The raffle item can be a basket of assorted items or one single item. Two or more shelter/clubs sharing a table may have a raffle item per shelter/club. The practice of providing eggs/lollypops/fortune cookies and silent auction with a specific item won in them is also acceptable. Shelter/rescue/club donation jars are highly encouraged.

Veterinarians and Health Info

For the health, safety and comfort of all animals and humans in the show hall, ferrets may be checked by a vet tech/assistant or show representative prior to entering the hall. This check may include looking for parasites (fleas, ear mites), mange, visible signs of illness (runny nose, mange, etc) and verify shot RABIES and ADV records. Those bringing in ferrets, even if not showing, must supply the proof of rabies vaccination and complete and sign the ADV check in form and a Distemper waiver at ENTRY. We would welcome any vet who would like to present a mini-seminar. Please contact the Event Chair if you are interested in doing a presentation.

Hotel/Motel Guidelines for Shows

Note: Because some ferret people have been irresponsible and have left their rooms in poor condition, snuck in without paying pet fees or allowed their ferrets to run free in public areas, we are finding it increasingly difficult to secure suitable housing for our shows. For this reason the American Ferret Association (AFA) has issued the following guidelines for exhibitors and show attendees to ensure that we continue to be welcomed at hotels/motels.

- 1. Ferrets are not to be placed on the floors and/or furniture in the hotel room, this includes the bed, floor and bathrooms.
- 2. If you are using a play pen to let your ferret get exercise you need to have a piece of tile or thick plastic underneath it to protect the floor from accidents and digging. Blankets do not work. This is to protect the hotel's carpet as well as to protect your pet. You do not know what was on that floor before you checked in.
- 3. Bring trash bags and paper towels for disposal of ferret litter and trash. Do not use hotel trash cans as the smell will penetrate the cans.
- 4. Owners need to bring their own towels for bathing ferrets. Hotel/Motel equipment should not be used for cleaning up accidents.
- 5. Owners should clean up any trash on the floor before they check out of the room. If the ferret has kicked litter or food on the floor this should be cleaned up by the owner before check out.
- 6. Rooms should be sprayed with an odor neutralizer such as Febreze or Oust to remove ferret odors right before check out.
- 7. Ferrets must be kept in their cages when going thru the hotel lobby and hallways. This INCLUDES NO letting ferret(s) run in hotel hallways, breakfast areas, pool areas or ANY other areas in the hotel!
- 8. If you are picking up a new ferret, brought your ferret(s) or any other pet with you, you MUST pay the pet fee, if applicable, for any animal staying in your room.

Please leave your room looking the way it was when you checked in.

Note** A hotel representative and/or host club will be doing random checks to make sure that these guidelines have been followed. Anyone violating the above guidelines will be charged for any additional cleaning/repair that is needed.

Also the following actions will be taken by the AFA:

First offense you will lose all championship points earned at the show where the offense took place.

Second offense you will be banned for life from all AFA sanctioned shows.
