

Tall Larkspur

This Native perennial is a great addition to the woodland border. It gets quite tall, but thrives in sun as well as shade. It adds a nice touch of color in late summer. Larkspur is an important nectar source for hummingbirds and butterflies. This plant is known to be drought resistant and can be utilized as a cut flower. It is a plant of special concern in Pennsylvania and is in need of a home.



Delphinium exaltatum

- Hardiness: Zone 5-8
- Size: 3-6'
- Flower: Blue flowers from July to September
- Culture: Prefers full sun to shade and average, rich well-drained soils. Does best in moisture-retentive, well-drained, humus-rich, slightly alkaline soils with filtered shade.
- Uses: Naturalizing, wood's edge, border, massing, butterflies, hummingbirds, birds, cut flower, drought tolerant
