Installation Resiliency




- ▶ **Military Bases Are Not an Island**

 - Majority of base workers live off-base
 - Support contractors have off-base resources
 - Base does not want to be a “light house” in the dark

<u>College Pond</u>	<p>Draft Bridge Hydraulic Recommendation Report For College Boulevard over College Pond, Okaloosa County</p> <p>Outline of three proposals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Remove spillway, utilize existing box culvert only• Remove spillway, construct bridge to span bankfull width + 10% to accommodate Okaloosa Darter. This option would result in a 72-ft long single span bridge.• Remove spillway, construct bridge to span floodplain to accommodate Okaloosa Darter. This option results in a 340-ft long bridge. Maintain pond similar to the Anderson Branch restoration project while reconnecting Swift Creek to open channel flow. FWC ARHES is interested supporting this project.
