1. Number with arrow below:

The number represents the hole on the harmonica.

The arrow represents the air direction.

2. Number with and without a minus (-) sign:

The number represents the hole on the harmonica.

The number alone is played with a blow (breathe out).

The number with a minus (-) sign is played with a draw (breathe in).

3. Number with 'B' or 'D':

The number represents the hole on the harmonica.

The number with a 'B' is played with a blow (breathe out).

The number with a 'D' is played with a draw (breathe in).

 $4D = draw on hole 4$

4. Number alone and circled with a minus (-) sign (our tablature):

The number represents the hole on the harmonica.
