Jim Arwood was one of five people recognized by the Arizona Republic newspaper last week as "solar pioneers" - key players in helping make solar power mainstream in the state of Arizona.

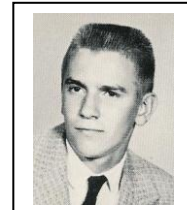
The article noted that Arwood "first became interested in energy issues in grade school, when the federal government proposed dumping nuclear waste in his hometown of Lyons, Kan.," a plan that was eventually scrapped.

Arwood was a member of the Phoenix Steering Committee for Sun Day, which helped plan the first big solar fair in the state on May 3, 1978, where homemade solar ovens, water heaters and greenhouses were displayed.
