'Please accept my heartfelt thanks For all the cards, letters & emails. To say they got me through a rough time is a huge understatement. I wish I'd been able to answer each individually but hope this note will Let all of you know how grateful & Well loved you made me feel.

After months spent getting a Diagnosis, treatment started in Tucson & seemed pretty mild but the experts here in FI didn't feel it had done any good & put me on a strong dose of chemo that involved a lengthy stay at the Moffitt



Cancer Center in Tampa, follow up at a care home there in Vero, then another hospital stay after which my V.B. Oncologist told me I almost died. It felt strange to hae gone through that and yet have not awareness of it. That was merciful because for part of that time I was able to take hallway walks even persuading one doctor to walk with me while we talked.

The good people who surrounded me made sure that laughter & humor stayed a part of life. My daughters were here a tremendous support as were all the medics some of whom began to feel like friends. During this part of my treatment some of you wrote telling me you had heard from friends who had been successfully treated for AML and pre-leukemia. I am considered in remission now and want to stay here but want to know my options.

Hope this finds all of you happy & full of heath & enjoying life-grandkids, kids, travel, eating and all the perks retirement brings.

Jim Arwood was one of five people recognized by the Arizona Republic newspaper last week as "solar pioneers" - key players in helping make solar power mainstream in the state of Arizona.

The article noted that Arwood "first became interested in energy issues in grade school, when the federal government proposed dumping nuclear waste in his hometown of Lyons, Kan.," a plan that was eventually scrapped.

Arwood was a member of the Phoenix Steering Committee for Sun Day, which helped plan the first big solar fair in the state on May 3, 1978, where homemade solar ovens, water heaters and greenhouses were displayed.
