## WELCOME TO THE TRUSTEES' CORNER

There have been a few changes to the Pull Tabs. There is a maximum purchase of \$30 at a time. This change is to help the bartenders when things are busy. It's up to their discretion if they want to sell more if things are slower but they can cap it at \$30 on busy days. Also, you are no longer able to hold a bowl. Anyone at any time can purchase from any bowl. There have been several issues arise from folks holding bowls, so it was in the best interest to eliminate the practice. Remember, the distribution of drinks is a higher priority than pull tabs. You may have to wait a bit until everyone ordering drinks has been helped. If you are sitting at the bar, you are in the same wait line as those standing. You do not get priority service just because you are at the bar. Drinks continue to be poured at 1.5 oz for a single and 3.0 oz for a double.

The new Volunteer Opportunities Board is up on the wall opposite the restrooms. If you see something on the board that you would like to do, contact Loni or a Trustee. The Trustees' meet every Wednesday at 5:30 pm in the

dining room. If you have questions, ideas, or issues, come see us.

Please remember that every bar worker, wait staff, kitchen worker, and event person you see is a volunteer ~ giving up their time to support the Aerie. **BE NICE TO THEM.** Without them, we wouldn't have a club. They deserve your respect and patience! Remember, when you come into the Aerie bar, it is your responsibility and state liquor law to show your card to the bartender. Do not make them ask you to see it and if they ask you multiple times throughout the night, show them multiple times without contempt. It is their job and the law.

The Trustees would like to encourage all Brothers and Sisters to attend Aerie and Auxiliary meetings. At the member meetings you can learn and understand how the Aerie and Auxiliary function, learn about the finances and business of the Aerie and Auxiliary, and maybe win a raffle or drawing.
