This event will be a basic navigation event using 6 figure map references and will suit both novices and experts alike. The event will take place solely on **Map 125**. You will also require:

Pens

Computer / Laptop / mobile phone /tablet (with access to Google street maps)

Beverages

No vehicles or modes of transport are to be used. It is a fully digital event and all answers have been found using Google street view.

There are two classes for this event, Experts and Novices. A Novice is defined as a competitor who has not won two or more overall, class or novice awards on any rally of National B or higher status.

There is no minimum or maximum entry for this event.

Competitors will receive their full route information, references and clues at 20:00hrs on 30.05.21 via email (MTC1). The location of the points to be visited will be defined by 6 figure map references (plotted using a basic romer).

All answers will be obtained from Google maps street view.

Final instructions will be found at the start of the first hand out in both classes

Each location will be worth a point. You must visit all points. The result will be decided by the shortest time upon receipt of answers received via email and points scored.

Timed to the minute.

Missed answer or wrong answer will result in a fail.

MTC 2 will close at 0800 31.05.21 the morning after (you can be early).
