SCENES:

Introduction w/banner

Mask seller sets up shop,
Mask seller (opens bags with masks in them),
Mask seller demonstrates putting on masks,
Mask seller entices audience to put on masks,

Guy enters shop,
Mask seller shows guy a mirror,
Guy is depressed at his appearance,
Mask seller shows a “studs” mask,
Mask seller puts on “stud” mask,
Guy wants it and buys it,
Mask seller asks for money,
Guy pays for it and put on mask,
Guy put on mask that is distorted on guy
Guy leaves stage
Mask seller laughs it off,

Christian enters scene,
Mask seller shows mirror to Christian,
Christian is not fazed,
Mask seller puts on “stud” mask,
Christian shares Gospel
Christian pricks at heart of mask seller,
Mask seller’s mask drops off,
Mask seller chases off Christian,

Girl who is extremely shy comes in
Girl comes in (bow legged and insecure),
Mask seller show mirror to girl,
Girl is ashamed and tries to cover up,
Mask seller puts on a “beautiful” mask,
Girl is excited and wants to buy it,
Mask seller asks for 1 dollar,
Girl gives 1 dollar,
Girl pays the amount as she ponders the mask and
is about to leave,
Mask seller stops girl,
Mask seller shows a full length mirror to girl
Girl is embarrassed,

Mask seller brings out a pre-fabricated body,
Mask seller shows “hour glass” body for sale,
Girl wants it and buys it.
Mask seller asks for 1 dollar,
Girl gives 1 dollar,
Mask seller asks for 2 dollars instead,
Mask seller at count of 3 interposes the frame
Girl is in awkward figure,
Mask seller “crank” it up and press “on” button,
Girl struggles as she walks out,
Mask seller laughs it off,

Thief enters smoking and scaring audience,
Mask seller is scared,
Mask seller shows mirror, mirror breaks on thief
Mask seller shows stud mask,
Thief won’t buy it,
Thief takes out a gun to robe the mask seller,
Mask seller in panic, puts on a “laughing face”,
Thief takes out a shot gun, puts to head of
mask seller,
Mask seller takes off mask, is in despair,
Mask seller takes all money out of pockets and
gives it to the thief,
Thief leaves with money,
Mask seller is distraught at loss of livelihood,

Christian enters scene walking along w/Bible ,
Mask seller puts on happy face,
Christian preaches to heart, mask falls
Mask seller is at a lose,
Mask seller wants to know about new heart,
Christian leads mask seller to Christ,
Mask seller prays to receive the LORD,
Mask seller overturns shop,
Mask seller and Christian leave discussing the
Word

END
