



NOTICE

FIRE BAN IN EFFECT

Northern Municipal Services, Ministry of Government Relations hereby notifies in supplementation to the Director's Order of Wildfire Management Branch, Ministry of Environment that came into effect at 5:00 p.m. on May 14th, 2018. **Effective immediately**, a Fire Ban is imposed in all Resort Subdivisions, Northern Settlements, cluster subdivisions, isolated titles and dispositions south of the Churchill River that are within the Northern Saskatchewan Administration District. **The Fire Ban includes all burning or open pit fires.** The Fire Ban is imposed due to wildfire hazards originating from extremely dry conditions.

Please note that the Fire Ban issued by the Wildfire Management Branch applies within that portion of Saskatchewan lying south of the Churchill River:

1. All provincial Crown land,
2. All lands lying within 4.5 km of the provincial forests boundary, and
3. Excepting Cypress Hills Interprovincial Park: all provincial parks and provincial recreation sites as described in *The Parks Act* and *The Parks Regulations, 1981*, including Clearwater River Provincial Park and Lac La Ronge Provincial Park

Otherwise, this Fire Ban will be cancelled effective from the time of cancellation of the Fire Ban of Wildfire Management Branch.
