- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe is responsible for personnel matters and the organization of operating policies to provide the best resources available for the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe on behalf of its tribal membership including tribal natural resources and staff; and
- WHEREAS, the Summit Lake Paiute Council has deemed it to be in the best interest of the Tribe, to update policies and procedures in order to comply with changes in federal regulations related to Anti-Harassment.
- **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Summit Lake Paiute Council, the governing body of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribe of Nevada, hereby submits the updated Sexual Harassment and Hostile Workplace Policy dated November 17, 2018 to be added to the Tribe's Personnel Manual.
- **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that the Summit Lake Paiute Council approves by Resolution the amending of the Summit Lake Paiute Tribes Sexual Harassment Policy to become the Sexual Harassment and Hostile Workplace Policy.
