The following week at Districts, the team took third, despite their #2 runner collapsing less than 200 meters from the finish. This qualified them for Regionals, where they finished 7th overall.

This team has definitely left their mark. 4 athletes will have their name placed on the stadium wall having posted some of the fastest times in Kings history. Sophomore Leah Maschino is #2, and just 0:15 seconds from the #1 spot. Junior Hannah Rasmussen is #4, Senior Hannah Chunn is #13 and Freshman Jennifer Cooper is #14.

The guys had a successful season finishing second in the ECC, just 7 points behind Anderson. The following week, the team ran past Elder at Districts to claim a spot in Regionals. At the Troy Regionals, the team finished 9th, but avenged their loss to Anderson at the event.

Sophomore Gideon Diebel also added his name to the all time list at #14. The coaches are really excited about next years team, as for the first time in their history, they could be returning 14 runners who ran sub 18 minute 5k's this year.
