



## **Sheridan Fire Protection District News**

Well, with spring like weather out, please be sure to watch for children out and about playing.

Also, don't forget about the scheduled Red Cross Blood drives scheduled for this year, Friday May 12th, Friday July 21st, Friday September 29th, and Friday November 17th. All drives are scheduled from 1-6 pm. Walk ins are welcome, but appointments are suggested to reduce your wait time. Contact the Red Cross on line at <u>redcrossblood.org</u> or by phone at 1-800-RED CROSS, with the date to schedule. The March drive netted 20 units from the community! Great job!



Sheridan Fire would like to take this time to update the community on things going on around the fire station. Last fall, the district took the initiative to upgrade the station apparatus floor from the old oil stained concrete to new, easy to clean epoxy. The project lasted several weeks and everything had to be removed from the building. Lots of work by all members.





In a joint effort between the Serena and Sheridan districts, a UTV (Utility Vehicle) and trailer was purchased and will be housed in Serena. The UTV will be available and priceless in assisting with fires and rescues in remote areas in both districts.

Also, in a joint effort, Serena and Sheridan received a \$10,000 grant from Compeer Financial for the purchase of a LUCAS CPR device. Additionally, each department received another unit from LaSalle County for EMS and First Responders. There are now a total of 3 of these devices available! Good things keep on happening!



## Resident Notices:

The Village of Sheridan will begin review of all properties within the village to ensure compliance with the Village of Sheridan Municipal Code beginning in early April. Areas in particular that will be focused on are below. You may read more code details on our website at: sheridan-il.us under the Municipal Code tab. We appreciate your assistance with this!

### Chapter 6 under the Nuisance Per Se section

It shall be declared to be a nuisance to allow garbage, refuse or rubbish to accumulate or to be collected in any place zoned by the Village of Sheridan as being in a residential district unless it is placed within a garbage container subject to pickup by a waste hauler no less frequently than twice a month.

<u>The Village of Sheridan has scheduled for our Spring Clean Up Day on</u> <u>May 12th-also Fall Clean Up Day will be October 13th.</u>

### Chapter 11-Plants and Weeds

It is unlawful for anyone to permit any weeds or grass to grow a height exceeding eight inches anywhere in the Village: any such weeds or grass exceeding such height are hereby declared to be a nuisance.

During the grass mowing/leaf raking season, please take special care to not allow grass clippings or leaves to be blown/raked onto our village streets. This creates a hazards to all vehicles, especially motorcycles which lose traction on grass and leaves easily. This is also a violation of Chapter 415 ILCS 105 Litter Control Act which prohibits the depositing of all litter, including lawn waste upon any public or private property.

#### Chapter 18-REMOVAL OF ABANDONED MOTOR VEHICLES

Village Ordinance states a "Junk Vehicle" is defined as a vehicle that is not in running condition, is not currently licensed or currently insured. Village Ordinance can be found on our website at www.sheridan-il.us under the Municipal Code of Sheridan.


It is not our desire to enforce this ordinance or cause fines and inconvenience to residents, however to keep Sheridan clean Zoning Enforcement will take place if necessary.

## **Residents:**

The Village of Sheridan is planning for this years sidewalk improvements! The Street and Alley Committee shall annually make a budget request for sidewalk improvement to the Finance Committee. During the month of April, the Village Board shall accept public comments of any landowner desiring financial assistance for repairs or replacement of sidewalk adjacent to their property. The Street and Alley Committee shall by April of each year present to the Village Board a resolution containing a sidewalk improvement plan. In selecting sidewalks to be placed on the sidewalk improvement plan, the Street and Alley Committee shall take into consideration the condition of any existing sidewalk, the need for a sidewalk, the expected traffic for the sidewalk, and whether an owner adjoining a sidewalk is willing to participate in a 60%/40% payment agreement where the owner agrees to pay 40% of the cost of sidewalk improvements with the City paying the remaining 60% costs of improvements. If a landowner fails to get a required sidewalk placed on the annual improvement plan, such landowner may repair or install a sidewalk in any street, alley or public ground adjacent to their property but only after approval of the plans and subject to conditions approved by the Street and Alley Committee. Conditions and standards for approval shall be similar to conditions and standards normally undertaken by the Street and Alley Committee for work performed as part of their annual plan for sidewalk improvements.
