## Bloomer Baptist Church To Know Christ and Make Him Known

#### Pastor's Portion

George Barna has done research for decades. In a recent survey the results are tragic. When asked a bunch of teens and 20's their views, here is their response on immoral things. 56% of these consider NOT recycling as immoral; while 32% consider viewing porn as immoral. The pole results share that only 20% of these young people feel *any* guilt in viewing porn. Young people today are exposed to porn at earlier and earlier ages. To further complicate the matter, people cannot agree on what is porn. Is it nudity, sex acts or what? Not so long ago one of the US Supreme Court Justice, Potter Stewart, made a pathetic reply when asked what is obscene? He said, "I know when I see it." We need to have more than just a floating standard.

A week ago I sent out a web site article by Denny Burk which was a commentary on the recent TIME magazine article on pornography. Burk quotes the author, Luscombe, of the TIME magazine as follows: <u>http://www.dennyburk.com/the-darkness-of-porn-and-the-hope-of-the-gospel/</u>

A growing number of young men are ... virtually marinated in porn when they were adolescents. Their generation has consumed explicit content in quantities and varieties never before possible, on devices designed to deliver content swiftly and privately, all at an age when their brains were more plastic—more prone to permanent change—than in later life.

What I find interesting is that it's not just religious people now seeing the harm in porn but society at large. (Examples: TIME article and recent Utah's Governor signed a resolution calling porn a "health hazard"). So I take courage in the fact that not just evangelicals see this as an issue but others do as well.

Our purpose at Bloomer Baptist is not to wring our hands over society's demise but to give solutions to live in a fallen world. Let me outline:

1. Know the power and pervasiveness of pornography. 1 Corinthians 6:18 (ESV) Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body.

2. Guard your own heart and mind. Set up safe guards such as Job 31:1 (ESV) *"I have made a covenant with my eyes; how then could I gaze at a virgin?"* Have an accountability partner to ask you the hard question of have your eyes wandered?

3. Keep accountability in our homes. Louis Inks years ago said at a youth seminar I attended. "It's not what you expect but what you inspect that gets done." Know what your kids **see** and **do** on their media tools. Have a frank discussion and then be sure to check their histories.

4. MOTIVATION: (Note: Most porn users think their sin of choice is an innocent pastime. Science has proven that it changes brains—article by TIME above). The motivation I find time and again is bigger than guilt. Take a look at these verses:

1 John 3:2–3 (ESV) Beloved, we are God's children now, and what we will be has not yet appeared; but we know that when he appears we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is. <sup>3</sup> And everyone who thus hopes in him purifies himself as he is pure.

Titus 2:11–13 (ESV) For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, <sup>12</sup> training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, <sup>13</sup> waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

Let me say one final word. Porn can be and often is a powerful addiction. A book I read by Arterburn mentioned that one of the founders of Alcoholics Anonymous, Bill W, was able to overcome his addiction to alcohol but never got victory over porn. Not to rake poor Bill W's name in the dirt but to emphasize you probably will need help to overcome. Pat and I would be glad to share materials and set up accountability, in a discreet manner, to help you. Contact us, we are ready to serve. -Pastor Eldon Carlson


