

**Prov 26:1** As snow in summer, and as rain in harvest, so honour is not seemly for a fool.

**Prov 26:2** As the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, so the curse causeless shall not come.

**Prov 26:3** A whip for the horse, a bridle for the ass, and a rod for the fool's back.

**Ps 32:9** Be ye not as the horse, or as the mule, which have no understanding: whose mouth must be held in with bit and bridle, lest they come near unto thee.

**Prov 26:4** Answer not a fool according to his folly, lest thou also be like unto him.

**Prov 26:5** Answer a fool according to his folly, lest he be wise in his own conceit.

**Prov 30:12** There is a generation that are pure in their own eyes, and yet is not washed from their filthiness.

**Isa 65:5** Which say, Stand by thyself, come not near to me; for I am holier than thou. These are a smoke in my nose, a fire that burneth all the day.

**Matt 9:11** And when the Pharisees saw it, they said unto His disciples, Why eateth your Master with publicans and sinners?

**Mark 4:16** *And these are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness;*

**Matt 16:1** The Pharisees also with the Sadducees came, and tempting desired him that he would shew them a sign from heaven.

**Matt 16:2** He answered and said unto them, *When it is evening, ye say, It will be fair weather: for the sky is red.*

**Matt 16:3** *And in the morning, It will be foul weather to day: for the sky is red and lowering. O ye hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky; but can ye not discern the signs of the times?*

**Matt 16:4** *A wicked and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given unto it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas.* And he left them, and departed.

**Luke 11:29** And when the people were gathered thick together, he began to say, *This is an evil generation: they seek a sign; and there shall no sign be given it, but the sign of Jonas the prophet.*

**Matt 12:38** Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered, saying, Master, we would see a sign from thee.

**Matt 12:39** But he answered and said unto them, *An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas:*

**Matt 12:40** *For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.*

**Matt 12:41** The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it:  
because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here.

**Matt 12:42** The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for she came from the uttermost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon is here.

**Prov 26:6** He that sendeth a message by the hand of a fool cutteth off the feet, and drinketh damage.

**Prov 26:7** The legs of the lame are not equal: so is a parable in the mouth of fools.

**Prov 26:8** As he that bindeth a stone in a sling, so is he that giveth honor to a fool.

**Prov 26:9** As a thorn goeth up into the hand of a drunkard, so is a parable in the mouth of fools.

**Prov 26:10** The great God that formed all things both rewardeth the fool, and rewardeth transgressors.

**Prov 26:11** As a dog returneth to his vomit, so a fool returneth to his folly.

**2Pet 2:22** But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.

**Prov 26:12** Seest thou a man wise in his own conceit? there is more hope of a fool than of him.

**Prov 3:7** Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.

**Rom 12:16** Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.

**Rom 12:18** If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.

**2Cor 13:11** Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you.

**1Pet 3:8** Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous:

**Prov 26:13** The slothful man saith, There is a lion in the way; a lion is in the streets.

**Prov 26:14** As the door turneth upon his hinges, so doth the slothful upon his bed.

**Prov 26:15** The slothful hideth his hand in his bosom; it grieveth him to bring it again to his mouth.

**Prov 26:16** The sluggard is wiser in his own conceit than seven men that can render a reason.

**Isa 5:21** Woe unto them that are wise in their own eyes, and prudent in their own sight!

**Rom 1:22** Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools,

**1Cor 1:20** Where is the wise? where is the scribe? where is the disputer of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?

**1Pet 3:15** But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:

**Ps 119:46** I will speak of thy testimonies also before kings, and will not be ashamed.

**Matt 10:18** And ye shall be brought before governors and kings for my sake, for a testimony against them and the Gentiles.

**Acts 12:1** Now about that time Herod the king stretched forth his hands to vex certain of the church.

**Titus 3:7** That being justified by His grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

**Mark 10:17** And when He was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to Him, and asked Him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?

**John 6:28** Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God?

**Acts 2:37** Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?

**Phil 1:29** For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for his sake;

**Eph 2:8** For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

**2Tim 3:12** Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.

**Ps 34:19** Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.

**Ps 34:4** I sought the LORD, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.

**Ps 9:10** And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.

**Matt 7:7** Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

**Matt 7:9** Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a stone?

[**Luke 11:9 -13**]

**Rom 4:18** Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations; according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.

**Gen 15:5** And He {The LORD} brought him{Abram} forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and He{The LORD} said unto him{Abram}, So shall thy seed be.

**Heb 11:12** Therefore sprang there even of one, and him as good as dead, so many as the stars of the sky in multitude, and as the sand which is by the sea shore innumerable.

**2Cor 5:7** (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

**Heb 11:1** Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

**Rom 8:24** For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for?

**Ps 34:6** This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him, and saved him out of all his troubles.

**Ps 34:17** The righteous cry, and the LORD heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles.

**Prov 26:17** He that passeth by, and meddleth with strife belonging not to him, is like one that taketh a dog by the ears.

**Prov 26:18** As a mad man who casteth firebrands, arrows, and death,

**Prov 26:19** So is the man that deceiveth his neighbour, and saith, Am not I in sport?

**Prov 26:20** Where no wood is, there the fire goeth out: so where there is no talebearer, the strife ceaseth.

**Prov 26:21** As coals are to burning coals, and wood to fire; so is a contentious man to kindle strife.

**Prov 15:18** A wrathful man stirreth up strife: but he that is slow to anger appeaseth strife.

**Prov 16:28** A froward man soweth strife: and a whisperer separateth chief friends.

**Prov 17:9** He that covereth a transgression seeketh love; but he that repeateth a matter separateth very friends.

**Prov 10:12** Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins.

**Prov 29:22** An angry man stirreth up strife, and a furious man aboundeth in transgression.

**Prov 26:22** The words of a talebearer are as wounds, and they go down into the innermost parts of the belly.

**Prov 26:23** Burning lips and a wicked heart are like a potsherd covered with silver dross.

**Prov 26:24** He that hateth dissembleth with his lips, and layeth up deceit within him;

**Ps 41:6** And if he come to see me, he speaketh vanity: his heart gathereth iniquity to itself; when he goeth abroad, he telleth it.

**Prov 26:25** When he speaketh fair, believe him not: for there are seven abominations in his heart.

**Prov 26:26** Whose hatred is covered by deceit, his wickedness shall be shewed before the whole congregation.

**Matt 23:28** Even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within ye are full of hypocrisy and iniquity.

**Prov 26:27** Whoso diggeth a pit shall fall therein: and he that rolleth a stone, it will return upon him.

**Prov 26:28** A lying tongue hateth those that are afflicted by it; and a flattering mouth worketh ruin.
