The Committee was honored to have a most distinguished guest, Dr. Jack W. Eichinger, Jr., of Ottumwa, Iowa. Dr. Eichinger received his B.S. in 1926 and his PHD in 1931 from Iowa State. He was an Instructor at Iowa State until 1934. From 1934 to 1941 he taught at the University of Detroit, from 1941 to 1944 he was an Instructor at Artillery School for the Army, from 1944 to 1946 he was Asst. Director of U.S. Military Academy, and from 1946 to 1948 he was Associate Professor at Williams College. Since 1948, Dr. Eichinger has been Professor of Chemistry at F.S.U. In 1956 and 1957 he was Executive Secretary of Florida Nuclear Development Commission and in July of 1957, Coordinator of Nuclear Science Program.

The Committee voted to accept Mr. Darlington's, Mr. O'Connor's and R. Dickinson's invitation to hold it's next quarterly meeting in Tampa on February 10, 1961.

Chairman Griffin then adjourned the meeting and the Committee moved to the dining area and enjoyed a delicious meal as guests of the Southeastern Telephone Company.
