Whether you drive into CBTB every day or haven't been there in years, the most important thing you can do is return the enclosed ballot! You might also say - I already voted, or my vote doesn't matter . . . but it DOES!

For the November vote for the dues increase, we only received 256 votes. Per our by-laws we needed 60% (355 votes) out of the 591 lots/votes in the community to reach a quorum. NO QUORUM WAS MET FOR THAT ROUND OF VOTING. So we have to do it again (spending more money and time mailing out another round of ballots). This time around though, per our by-laws, we only need to receive 178 votes for a quorum. So PLEASE RETURN YOUR BALLOT!

A Snapshot of the Proposed Dues Increase

History of CBTB Dues -- We have not had an increase since 1997.

1967- \$20.00 1981- \$50.00 1970- \$28.50 1986- \$60.00 1973- \$40.00 1997- \$80.00

Why Do We Need A Dues Increase?

- We need to maintain our amenities and have capital reserves for future costs so we can continue to have a healthy and viable community
- Helps to maintain our real estate values
- We also would like to reduce and/or eliminate the need for special assessments, giving you a better idea what to plan or budget for on an annual basis
- Virginia Code (Law) Chapter 26, Property Owners' Association Act, Section 55-514.1 requires a capital reserve study and the need to budget for reserves and accumulation of cash.

Proposal

- The Finance Committee is recommending to the Board and the Community we increase the annual assessment from \$80.00 per lot to \$180.00 per lot. (Approximately \$15 per month per lot.)
- This increase will help cover the annual operating budget of \$65,000 plus this will begin to build up the capital reserve account.

How We Calculated The Increase To \$180.00

- We took the existing operating budget of \$65,000
- We extensively evaluated, reduced and adjusted the Capital Reserve Report to determine what should be included and how much we needed to save

180 x 591 CBTB Lots =	\$106,380
Annual Budget =	\$ 65,000
Amount added to Capital Reserve =	\$ 41,380
Full Capital Reserve Study requires =	= \$ 42,500
