January's Meeting Minutes:

Seneschal's Report: Aesa reported the New Years Moot was well attended. She is still working on getting zip codes for Tads members who have now become part of Windhaven in order to reach out to them. The Baronial website will need a new map updated. Also, picture release forms will be held by the seneschal in the future so there is one spot to keep them. The seneschal can then provide pictures to the social media and webminster to update the appropriate places and keep our pictures updated to show current events.

Chatelaine Report: Lord Eysteinn reported that the dates for the Fall Midwest Viking Fest have been chosen by UWGB and didn't give any options for the dates. It conflicts with other events but if you are thinking of attending, it will be held September 19th - 20th. They need help Thursday night to prep around 4pm. Also, they need assistance for tear down Saturday night after the event.

Exchequer Report: Hilde Steward reported that the annual budget is being sent with the Doomsday report.

The funds are now as follows: General Fund: \$6.282.81 Practice Fund: \$212.61 Event Fund: \$1,164.74

Total: \$7.660.16

- Spring Crown Bid Approval In May, same site as Fighter's School. Site tokens are done and will look at a lunch menu when it gets closer.

New Business:

- Chatelain Position Available No one stepped forward so it will be up for a vote in February. Note that the current Chatelain must step down as they are stepping up as Baron at Fighter's School.
- MoAS Position Available Taleza Alijohar (Charlotte Yeramian) was voted in as the new MoAS Officer.
- Equestrian Practices Balthazar would like to setup equestrian practices in the future, including mounted archery, at Artisan Stables. There is the potential for rental horses for qualified riders. For Insurance

purposes, he needs to book dates. Proposed dates included: 3/29, 4/26, 5/31, 6/28, 7/19, 8/23, 9/27, 10/25, 11/8 From 10am - 3pm (perhaps earlier in the summer when it is hot mid-day).

Royalty Gate Payment at Fighter's School

- The SCA holds no policy for waiving gate fees for royalty. Northshield's policy is to waive gate fees for coronation and crown events.
- Windhaven Policy Northshield sovereigns do not pay gate fees, and if they cannot attend, then Northshield Heirs are waived gate fees. Visiting Royalty fees may be individually waived by a vote at a business meeting or via a Quorum of greater officers.
- We have three sets of Royalty attending Fighter's School. NS Sovereigns, NS Heirs, and Midrealm's Sovereigns.
- Vote will be held next meeting to waive fees for all attending royalty.
- Financial Policy Proposed Changes Hilde would like to propose some changes
 to the windhaven financial policy after the
 above vote is complete. The recommended
 changes will be included below:

=== Current Bylaw: ===

V. Financial Policies

j. The Sovereigns of Northshield are not required to pay site and feast fees for an event financially sponsored by Windhaven. This privilege would extend to their Heirs in the Sovereign's absence. Waiving of fees for other visiting royalty must be individually approved at a business meeting or a quorum of Great Officers.

=== Proposed Bylaw ===

V. Financial Policies

j. The Sovereigns-Crown and Heirs of Northshield are not required to pay site and feast fees for an event financially sponsored by Windhaven. This privilege would extend to their Heirs in the Sovereign's absence. Feasts are defined as fixed-price pre-determined meals and ala carte meal offerings provided by the barony. Waiving of fees for other visiting royalty must be individually

approved at a business meeting or a quorum of Great Officers.

Hilde's reasoning:

- 1. The Royals would no longer be 'competing for tickets'
- 2. We can give a quick and easy answer of "Are my tickets comped?" to the Heirs.
- Replace "Sovereigns" with "Crown" to bring language in line with Kingdom verbiage. This is the only place in the Windhaven Bylaws where "Sovereign" was used.
- 4. Proposed update will more clearly define what is included as 'feast' with regards to questions about ala carte versus "sit down" meals. It will also prevent confusion on out-of-scope comps such as individual vendors providing food/drink.
- 5. Both CAM and Nordskogen currently comp Crown and Heirs tickets and feast and this would bring consistency with our nearest neighbors. (I was unable to locate Jaravellir's bylaws.)
