Ohio Hands & Voices (OHV) is a statewide nonprofit dedicated to supporting families of children who are deaf or hard of hearing. OHV is a parent led organization that offers families resources, networks, and information they need to improve communication access and educational outcomes for their children. Our organization is unique because we offer unbiased support to parents and families of all communication modes and methodologies. We believe that families make the best choices for their child. OHV is an affiliate of Hands & Voices, Inc, an international organization.

OHV *impacts* the lives of others by providing support and resources for families through our Advocacy, Support, and Training (ASTra) program and Side by Side program. These programs offer 1:1 direct support to families with trained parent leaders, webinars, workshop/conferences, locally developed resources, social media, newsletters, advocacy and special education support and guidance, family play dates, coffee chats, and more.

OHV has an operating budget under \$15,000 and employs one part-time staff person, our Executive Director. OHV has a reach of over 900 individual parents, families, and professionals through social media platforms and we have an average of 1,104 visits to our website monthly. In 2016, we established both ASTra and Side by Side programs. We have six volunteers trained and certified as ASTra Advocates and four parent volunteers serving as mentors to other families in our Side by Side program. This past year, we have reached over 1,100 parents, families, and professionals to offer support and resources through our programs. We want to continue to expand our programs with 1:1 services to families, train additional advocates and parent mentors, and continue to offer an annual workshop and conference for parents, families, and professionals who work with children who are deaf or hard of hearing.
