"Working slot" includes all activities; "Audit" includes Mark's lecture on Saturday only, but auditors may and are encouraged to observe and participate in discussion during all stages of the workshop.

Important Workshop information for working spot participants:

- Judge prospects (and licensed judges, at least once every three years) must purchase the working slot option and perform all stages for the workshop to count toward their judge certification or continuing education. **Working slot entrants must also submit course designs to Mark by email before Aug 26th** (one complete single trial, Novice through Master with Crazy 8s between Open and Senior). A diagram of the rings will be provided in adequate time for the design exercise.
- Please design one trial's worth of courses, with the class order being Novice-Open-Crazy 8s-Senior-Master (five courses). Before beginning, please refamiliarize yourself with the course design and map requirements as defined in the rule books. **Send Mark your course-builder maps in PDF format as a single file with all courses enclosed by email to mnshaw@gmail.com. Include an additional 2-3 premarked maps each for Crazy 8s, Senior, and Master.**
- You may (and are encouraged to) send your map file at any time before that deadline. Mark will provide feedback by email or in person at or before the workshop. Your courses/maps will be critiqued during the lecture/discussion portion of the workshop. Please also bring one set of printed course-builder maps (one side only) to the workshop. Some courses will be built and critiqued for experience and/or practice judging.
- Lecture/Discussion: This will be a classroom-style activity with a PowerPoint presentation and a significant amount of interactive discussion. Bring your questions about the sport, judging practice, rules, or anything else. It's also recommended that you bring material to take notes.

- Practice Judging: Working-slot participants will take turns judging dogs on selected from the maps submitted. Again: please review the rule books so that you will be able to properly handle any unexpected events in the ring.
- Dogs. Working participants do not work dogs at this Workshop, and dogs are not allowed in the lecture room. We want you to focus on learning which is difficult to do when you have a dog. Auditors may be allowed to work dogs during the practice period depending on the presenter.
 - Crating space will be available in the building if the dogs remain quiet. Disruptive dogs will need to be crated in vehicles. Dogs brought on site *may* be asked to run courses submitted for the course-building session.
- A copy of the Barn Hunt rule book will be provided to each working spot participant, as well as some note-taking material. Please bring anything you think you may need beyond this.

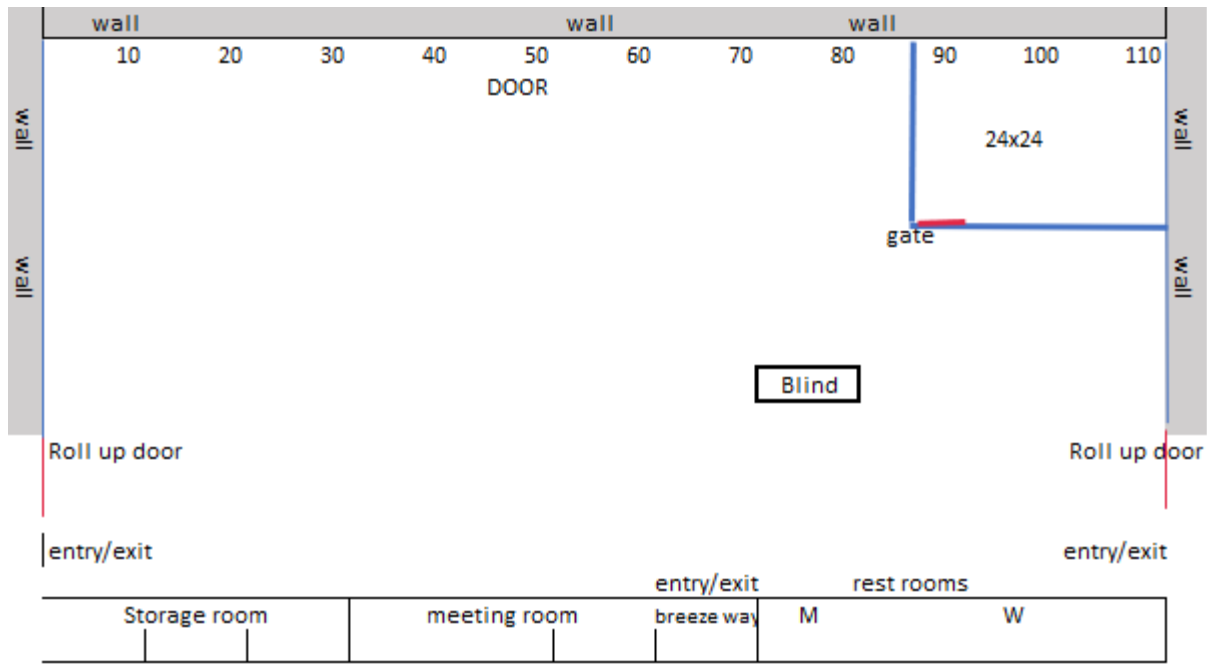
1. I will abide by the procedures listed above.
