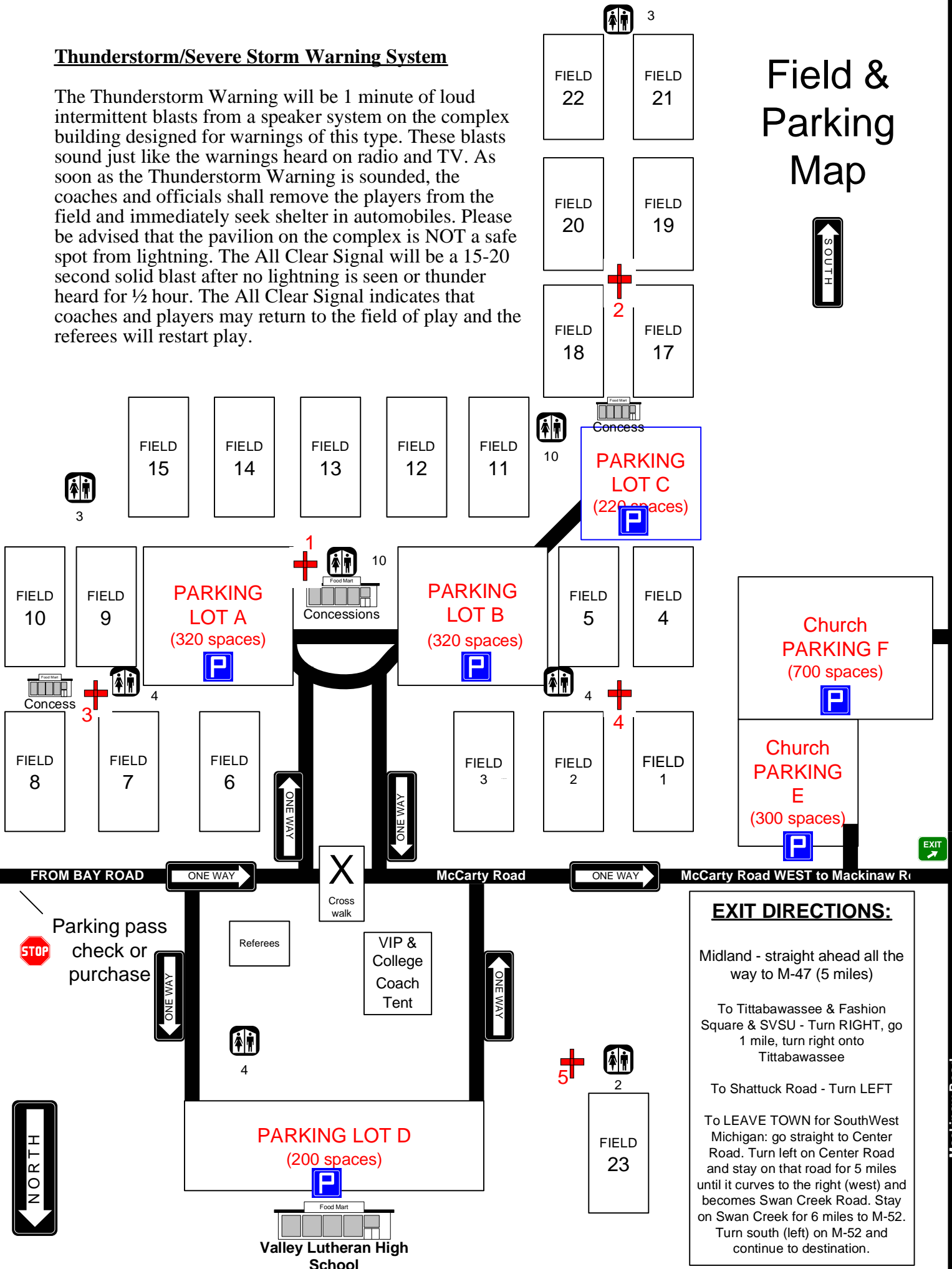


Thunderstorm/Severe Storm Warning System

The Thunderstorm Warning will be 1 minute of loud intermittent blasts from a speaker system on the complex building designed for warnings of this type. These blasts sound just like the warnings heard on radio and TV. As soon as the Thunderstorm Warning is sounded, the coaches and officials shall remove the players from the field and immediately seek shelter in automobiles. Please be advised that the pavilion on the complex is NOT a safe spot from lightning. The All Clear Signal will be a 15-20 second solid blast after no lightning is seen or thunder heard for ½ hour. The All Clear Signal indicates that coaches and players may return to the field of play and the referees will restart play.

EXIT DIRECTIONS:

- Midland - straight ahead all the way to M-47 (5 miles)
- To Tittabawassee & Fashion Square & SVSU - Turn RIGHT, go 1 mile, turn right onto Tittabawassee
- To Shattuck Road - Turn LEFT
- To LEAVE TOWN for SouthWest Michigan: go straight to Center Road. Turn left on Center Road and stay on that road for 5 miles until it curves to the right (west) and becomes Swan Creek Road. Stay on Swan Creek for 6 miles to M-52. Turn south (left) on M-52 and continue to destination.
